## Rotterdam to stage Davis Cup by NEC Semifinal

The KNLTB has announced that the Sportspalace Ahoy' in Rotterdam will stage the Netherlands' first ever Davis Cup semifinal from 21-23 September. The venue, which has held a major indoor men's event every year since 1972, holds 8,800 spectators and the tie will be staged on a Supreme carpet court.

The Netherlands are enjoying home advantage for the third tie running, having upset defending champion Spain 4-1 in the first round in Eindhoven, and Germany 4-1 in the second round in 's-Hertogenbosch last month. France meanwhile faces its third successive away trip as it bids to reach a second final in three years. Australia, who host Sweden in the second semifinal, have until 29 May to confirm its choice of venue.

## Tennis Masters Cup tickets go on sale

Tickets for this year's Tennis Masters Cup in Sydney from 12-18 November went on sale on Saturday 12 May.

Ticketek (Tel: +61 3 9266 4020) will be selling tickets to the tennis tournament, where the world's eight best players battle to earn their share of US\$3.7 million in prize money and potentially be crowned World No. 1.

The competition to qualify for a place in the tennis world's season-ending championship is fierce. Only the eight leaders of the ATP Champions Race 2001 will play at the Sydney SuperDome and Andre Agassi is leading the charge.

Agassi has performed so well in the first five months of the year, winning the Australian Open and Tennis Masters Series events in Indian Wells and Key Biscayne, that he is already close to qualifying.

Tournament Promoter Simon Baggs said that fans will have the chance to watch these modern-day gladiatorial battles for very affordable prices. "All the matches will be played on centre court but the Sydney SuperDome holds 17,500 seats for tennis. With eight sessions of play, there will be plenty of great seats. We don't want anyone to miss out, which is why we priced the tickets as low as AUS\$14 for our Special Matinee session."

From Monday 12 - Thursday 15 November, two matches will be played in the evening from 6.00pm. On Thursday 15 November, there will be a Special Matinee session for one round robin match. On Friday 16 November, there will be three matches played from 4.30pm.

The semifinals and final will begin at 2.00pm on Saturday 17 and Sunday 18 November respectively.
