Early shocks at Junior Wimbledon

Top seed Anastasia Pavlyuchenkova (RUS) suffered a shock 61 76(10) first round defeat to Kristina Kucova (SVK) as Junior Wimbledon got underway on Saturday. The Russian was the overwhelming favourite to add the Wimbledon title to her Australian Open crown, and her defeat leaves the draw wide open.

In Pavlyuchenkova's absence, the leading girls' contenders include last year's runner-up Tamira Paszek (AUT); Ayumi Morita (JPN), who reached the third round at this year's WTA grass court event at Birmingham; and Australian Open finalist Caroline Wozniacki (DEN). Yung-Jan Chan (TPE) and Alisa Kleybanova (RUS), both currently ranked in the top 200 on the WTA rankings, will also be tough to beat.

The top seed in the boys' event, Thiemo De Bakker (NED), opened his campaign today. De Bakker has dominated the Junior Circuit this year, compiling a 36-3 win-loss record and claiming five titles. However two of his three defeats have come at Grand Slam events and he is still searching for that elusive first major. The Dutch player has a good record on grass, having reached the third round at Wimbledon last year, and winning last week's International Junior Championships at Roehampton.

De Bakker's main rivals include Donald Young, last year's ITF Junior World Champion and a threat at any junior tournament he plays. Young was a semifinalist at last year's Wimbledon and is looking to claim his second Grand Slam title. Alexandre Sidorenko (FRA), the current Australian Open champion, suffered a first round defeat on Saturday, but No. 2 seed and Roland Garros champion Martin Klizan (SVK) will look to continue his recent run of form.

The last five Grand Slam boys' champions have been unseeded, and it is possible that Wimbledon will also have a surprise winner this week. Dangerous floaters in the draw include Philip Bester (CAN), the Roland Garros finalist; and Roberto Bautista Agut (ESP), who pushed De Bakker to three sets in the final at Roehampton last week.

Strong entry for Wimbledon wheelchair tournament

The world's top eight ranked men's doubles wheelchair players will line up for the Wimbledon Masters Series, part of the NEC Wheelchair Tennis Tour, to be held at The Championships, Wimbledon over the finals weekend of 8-9 July.

ITF Wheelchair World Champion Michael Jeremiasz of France and Great Britain's Jayant Mistry will defend the title that they won at last year's inaugural event. The pair will face tough competition from Athens Paralympic Games gold medallists and No. 1 seeds Satoshi Saida and Shingo Kuneida of Japan.

The four-team field is completed by Austria's Martin Legner and Dutchman Robin Ammerlaan, and Czech Miroslav Brychta and Tadeusz Kruszelnicki of Poland.

With the best 14 & under players from so many different countries taking part, the tour provides an excellent chance to assess the quality and game style of the next generation."

Hall of Fame honours Cochrane

The International Tennis Hall of Fame announced that Jim Cochrane of Great Britain is the 2006 recipient of its prestigious Golden Achievement Award.

Cochrane has served the sport of tennis for over 25 years. In 1981, he was Chairman of The Lawn Tennis Association, and then served as the organisation's President from 1982-84. From 1981-93 he was a member of the Committee of Management of The Championships at Wimbledon. From 1987-95 Cochrane served the ITF as a member of the Committee of Management, Chairman of the Medical Commission, the Finance Committee, Rules of Tennis, Rules of the ITF, Constitutional Committee, and the Technical Committee. Presently, he is an ITF Honorary Life Counsellor.

Cochrane was presented with the award on 2 July by J. Howard "Bumpy" Frazer, Chairman of the Hall of Fame's International Council at the Queen's Club in London, England during the International Tennis Hall of Fame's Board of Directors Meeting.
