## Luzhniki stadium to stage Fed Cup Final

The ITF confirmed that the Final of the 2007 Fed Cup by BNP Paribas between Russia and Italy will take place at the Luzhniki Small Sports Arena in Moscow subject to a successful ITF site visit. The tie will be hosted by the Russian Tennis Federation on 15-16 September, with seating capacity for 6,500 spectators. The surface has yet to be confirmed.

The Small Sports Arena was the venue for Russia's 2007 Fed Cup first round victory over Spain in April, and the same month it hosted the Davis Cup by BNP Paribas quarterfinal against France, with Russia winning 3-2 to reach the semifinals. Russia's Davis Cup semifinal against Germany will be held in Moscow the week after the Fed Cup final at the Olympic Stadium on 21-23 September.

Russia has won all three previous meetings against Italy in Fed Cup, including a 4-1 World Group first round victory in Brindisi in 2005. Ironically that was Italy's last defeat in the competition, before its current six-match winning streak that included its first Fed Cup title in 2006.

The draw for the 2008 Fed Cup by BNP Paribas will be held during the Fed Cup Final week on Friday 14 September. Russia and Italy will head the seedings for the 2008 World Group as the 2007 finalists, while all other seedings will be based on the current ITF Fed Cup Nations Ranking

## Olympic test event set for October

The ITF confirmed that the test event for the 2008 Beijing Olympic Tennis Event will be held at the Beijing Olympic Tennis Centre on 8-14 October 2007. The test event will be a mixed ITF Pro Circuit event featuring a men's \$15,000 Futures and women's \$25,000 tournament.

All aspects of the facility will be tested during the event, with representatives of the ITF's Event Operations, Communications and Officiating departments in attendance, and an Olympic Committee meeting held on site. Construction of the Beijing Olympic Tennis Centre remains on target for completion in early September.

The Olympic Tennis Event will use Hawk-Eye Officiating as its electronic line-calling system on two main show courts, the 10,000-seat Centre Court and 4,000-seat Court One. Hawk-Eye Officiating is currently used by three of the four Grand Slam events.

## Tennis mourns Jim Cochrane

Jim Cochrane, who served the sport of tennis at international level for over 26 years, died on Tuesday 17 July after a brief and sudden illness. He is survived by his wife Margaret Mary and her two children, Lavell and Dickon.

Cochrane was a member of the ITF Committee of Management from 1987-1995, and was also Chairman of the Medical Commission and several other committees: Finance, Rules of Tennis, Rules of the ITF, Constitutional, and Technical. More recently he became an AGM Parliamentarian and Honorary Life Counsellor.

Cochrane became Chairman of the LTA in 1981 and then served as President 1982-1984. From 1981-1993 he was a member of the Committee of Management of The Championships at Wimbledon. A former Board Member of the International Tennis Hall of Fame and a member of their International Council, he was presented with the ITHF Golden Achievement Award in 2006. In 1984, he was awarded the CBE (Commander of the British Empire).

ITF President Francesco Ricci Bitti said: "Jim devoted long and outstanding service to the sport of tennis throughout his career. In particular, he is credited with starting the Tennis Anti-Doping Programme as Chairman of the Medical Commission, and made important contributions towards wheelchair tennis and disabled sport."

## South East European Regional Training Camp

Thirty-six players and nine coaches from the Balkan and Caucasus region took part in the fourth ITF/Tennis Europe South East Regional Training Camp for players aged 12 & under in Ankara, Turkey on 17-22 July. The camp, supervised by ITF/Tennis Europe Development Officer Hrvoje Zmajic, featured participants from Albania, Azerbaijan, Bosnia, Bulgaria, Georgia, Macedonia, Montenegro and Turkey.

During the camp, players had the opportunity to improve their technical and tactical skills with special attention on developing successful playing patterns suitable for their age and individual characteristics, and took part in an international 12 & under tournament at the Ankara Tennis Club.

Organiser Birol Vural of the Ankara Tennis Club said: "Having players from eight different countries allows them to practise and compete with juniors of different backgrounds and playing levels. It was especially important for our Turkish players who don't have enough opportunities to measure their level with the most promising juniors from other European countries. It also enables our coaches to see the level of the players from these nations."

## Kunieda and Vergeer head British Open entry

Shingo Kunieda (JPN) and Esther Vergeer (NED) head the entry for the 18th British Open Wheelchair Championships in Nottingham on 24-29 July. The event is one of only four Super Series events on the 2007 NEC Wheelchair Tennis Tour, and also offers the highest number of ranking points of any competition.

Eight of the world's top ten have entered both the men's and women's events, with world No. 1 Vergeer bidding for her seventh successive title. Kunieda, the men's world No. 1, will face strong challenges from titleholder and current world champion Robin Ammerlaan (NED), and fast rising Frenchman Stephane Houdet, having lost to both players recently.

Britain's Peter Norfolk has been forced to pull out of the quad event with a shoulder injury, leaving world No. 2 David Wagner (USA) heading an entry of nine of the world's top ten players. ## NEWS IN BRIEF

### Olympic 'Mock Entry' procedure

The ITF is writing to National Associations this week with a 'Mock Entry List' of athletes who would be eligible for the 2008 Olympic Tennis Event if the ranking of the week commencing 11 June 2007 were used. This is only a test and the named athletes may or may not be eligible next year.

This procedure reflects the process that will be used for the Olympic Games next year, and is designed to encourage National Associations to contact their respective National Olympic Committee (NOC) to discuss entry criteria.

### Early qualifiers for Masters Cup

The world's leading singles players and Wimbledon finalists, Roger Federer and Rafael Nadal, and the top-ranked doubles pairing of Bob and Mike Bryan, have all secured their places in the prestigious circuit finale, the Tennis Masters Cup Shanghai, to be held for the third year at Qi Zhong Stadium on 11-18 November.

Federer, the winner in 2003-04 and 2006, said: "I look forward to returning to Shanghai to defend my Tennis Masters Cup title. Winning there was a perfect ending to last season and I love playing in China."
