

Date makes successful ITF Pro Circuit return

Kimiko Date-Krumm made an astonishing comeback to professional tennis when she came through qualifying to reach the final of the \$50,000 ITF Women's Circuit event in Gifu, Japan last week. She went on to win the doubles title with fellow Japanese player Kurumi Nara.

The 37-year-old former world No. 4 has not played on the professional circuit since announcing her retirement at the 1996 WTA Tour Championships at the age of 26. Last month she confirmed her intention to play in the doubles at three ITF Women's Circuit events, partnering three young Japanese players in order that they could benefit from her experience.

Date-Krumm then decided to challenge herself by playing singles qualifying, with over 4000 spectators and 150 media turning up for her opening qualifying match. She went on to win seven matches to reach the final, including defeats of top seed Aiko Nakamura (JPN) and third seed Melanie South (GBR), before finally losing to second seed Tamarine Tanasugarn (THA) 46 75 62. She then partnered 16-year-old Nara to a 61 67(8) [10-7] doubles final victory over South and Nicole Thyssen (NED).

Date-Krumm, who spent over 22 hours on court during the week, said: "I could not expect to be in the final in both singles and doubles. I never felt tired even though I played 12 matches in one week. I want to show people that tennis is a great sport and support future Japanese players. I want to be their stepping stone."

ITF Beach Tennis Tour underway

The inaugural tournament on the 2008 ITF Beach Tennis Tour got underway in Rome yesterday. The two-week tournament features players from Italy, Belgium, Spain and San Marino and takes place on a man-made beach tennis court at the Foro Italico alongside the ATP Tour Masters Series and Tier I WTA Tour events.

Total prize money of €25,000 is on offer to the participants in the men's and women's doubles competitions, one of the largest ever prize money pots for a beach tennis tournament. Participants will also earn ranking points towards their ITF Beach Tennis world ranking.

The highlight of the season will be the European Team Championships in August, which will take place in Riccione, Italy. Last year's Championships was dominated by the Italian team, but the defending champions can expect a strong challenge from 2007 finalists Belgium, as well as teams from Germany and Portugal.

Fifteen more teams reach ITF junior finals

Following last week's qualifying events, fifteen teams have booked their places at the ITF junior team competition finals in San Luis Potosi, Mexico and Prostějov, Czech Republic.

Sixteen nations participated in the Asia/Oceania final qualifying for Junior Davis Cup by BNP Paribas in New Delhi, India. The four qualifying places went to winner India, runner-up Japan, third placed Australia and fourth placed Chinese Taipei.

The South America World Junior Tennis Competition qualifying was held in Caracas, Venezuela, with Brazil defeating Peru in the boys' final. Both teams qualified for the World Junior Tennis Finals, alongside Venezuela who finished third. Bolivia took the top spot in the girls' qualifying and will be joined in Prostějov by runner-up Brazil.

The final qualifying event of the North/Central America & Caribbean region for both competitions took place on 2-4 May in Montreal, Canada. USA won all four events while host nation Canada achieved the second qualifying spot in both boys' and girls' 14 & under events.

The Asia/Oceania qualifying for Junior Fed Cup takes place on 5-10 May in Bangkok, Thailand. Sixteen teams will compete for the four places at the Finals. The South America qualifying for Junior Davis Cup & Junior Fed Cup by BNP Paribas also started yesterday in Santiago, Chile.

Wimbledon Centre Court alterations



The All England Club, Wimbledon has announced changes to the facilities at this year's competition. Centre Court will feature a new permanent non-moveable roof, with the installation of the new retractable roof on target to be in place by 2009. The seating capacity on Centre Court has increased by 1200 and the East and North Stands boast new public and debenture restaurants and lounges. These changes are part of a three-year plan to transform Centre Court.

In the second year of equal prize money, the Men's and Ladies' Singles Champions will receive £750,000 each, an increase of 7.1% on last year. The total prize fund has increased by 4.7% to over £11.8 million.
