## ITF confirms semifinal venues

The venues for the Davis Cup by BNP Paribas semifinal ties between Argentina and Russia, and Spain and USA, to be played on 19-21 September, have been announced.

Argentina will be looking to extend its unbeaten home run of 12 ties when it hosts Russia on clay at the Estadio Parque Roca in Buenos Aires. The two nations last faced each other in the 2006 final when Russia emerged victorious 3-2 in Moscow.

The Spanish Tennis Federation has chosen the Plaza de Toros de Las Ventas in Madrid for the showdown between Spain and titleholders USA. Spain lost to USA in the quarterfinals last year and will be looking to reach the final for the first time since winning the title in 2004.

## Rome hosts inaugural ITF Beach Tennis Tour event




The Internazionali BNL d'Italia ATP Rome Masters was not the only event being overseen by the giant marble statues at Rome's Foro Italico last week. The inaugural event of the ITF Beach Tennis Tour also took place in the grounds of Italy's historic centre of sporting excellence on a court built especially for the Grade 1 tournament and the action lived up to its majestic surroundings.




The 30 pairs in last week's men's event contained many of Italy's top players, as well as a handful of international talent from Spain, Belgium and San Marino. However, the overseas contingent did not make it past the second round as the Italian players showed their class from the early rounds.



In the end number two seeds Alan Maldini and Luca Meliconi (ITA) emerged victorious after they defeated No. 5 seeds Massimo Romani and Luca Rosatone (ITA) 36 63 62 in a tense but thrilling final.

Tomorrow will see the start of the equivalent women's event, played concurrently with the Sony Ericsson WTA Tour Tier I tournament, with the draw again predominantly made up of Italian pairs.

## Argentina, Chile and Uzbekistan win junior qualifiers

The last Asia/Oceania qualifying event for the 2008 ITF junior team competitions was staged in Bangkok, Thailand last week, with 16 girls teams contesting four spots for the finals in the Junior Fed Cup by BNP Paribas finals in San Luis Potosi, Mexico. Top seed Uzbekistan defeated China to win the event, with both teams qualifying for the finals alongside losing semifinalists Chinese Taipei and Korea.

The South America qualifying event for Junior Davis Cup & Junior Fed Cup by BNP Paribas also took place last week in Santiago, Chile. Ten boys' and girls' teams competed for three available places at the finals in Mexico. Argentina won the boys' event and will be joined in the finals by runner-up Brazil and third placed Peru. Host nation Chile won the girls' event to qualify for the finals and will be joined by runner-up Paraguay and third placed Colombia.

Qualification for the 2008 junior team finals has now been completed on all continents except Europe, where the European Summer Cups will serve as qualifying events. The finals of the boys' Copa del Sol and girls' Europa Cup, to be held on 4-6 July, will determine the remaining four boys' and five girls' teams to qualify for Prostějov. The finals of the boys' Borotra Cup and girls' Helvetie Cup, which take place 30 July-1 August, will determine the remaining four boys' and five girls' teams to qualify for San Luis Potosi in September. ## Burundians dominate East Africa training camp

Hassan Ndayishimiye (BDI) and Jimmy Nsabimana (BDI) won the two tournaments at the East Africa 14 & under camp held last week in Bujumbura, Burundi.

The training camp, which featured featuring eight players from Burundi and eight from various countries within the region, was divided into two periods of five days, each made up of a two-day training camp followed by a three-day tournament. The two mini-camps were conducted by the ITF Development Officer for East Africa, Prince Madema, and Rosemary Owino from Kenya.

Ndayishimiye stormed to victory over Kenya's Derrick Onyancha 62 63 in the first tournament and reached the final of the second tournament before narrowly losing to compatriot Jimmy Nsabimana 76(8) 16 64.

Prince Madema, ITF Development Officer for East Africa said: "Having the chance to train intensively at the camp gave the players a great opportunity to develop their games in a competitive environment."

## Wheelchair players head to Japan

Many of the world's top wheelchair players will contest the Japan Open this week as the 12-month qualification period for the Beijing Paralympics comes to a tense and high profile end. The world rankings of Monday 19 May will be used to determine direct entry qualification for Beijing. The Japan Open, which is held in Fukuoka, is one of five NEC Tour events this week and one of three tournaments to end on Sunday, the final day of the qualification period.

More than 150 players are competing in Japan, with the field headed by seven of the world's top ten men, seven of the world's top ten women and nine of the world's top ten quads. On home soil, world No. 1 and defending champion Shingo Kunieda (JPN) will be a warm favourite to win the men's main draw singles for the third successive year.

Esther Vergeer (NED) will be an even hotter favourite for the women's singles, but the world No. 1 will have to look out for compatriot and world No. 2 Korie Homan, who has already taken Vergeer to three sets this year.

In the quad singles defending champion David Wagner (USA) and former champion Peter Norfolk (GBR) could be heading for another final showdown, with Sarah Hunter (CAN) and Dutch trio Bas Van Erp, Dorrie Timmermans-Van Hall and Monique de Beer among their main opposition.
