## Countdown to Roland Garros

The 2008 Roland Garros championships begin this Sunday, 25 May, the third year the tournament has had a Sunday start. The opening day's play will see 16 men's and 16 women's matches scheduled on eight courts, including the three principle show courts. French players have received 11 of the 16 wild cards on offer, with Australian duo Robert Smeets and Samantha Stosur and America's Wayne Odesnik and Madison Brengle receiving wild cards thanks to a reciprocal agreement with Tennis Australia and the USTA. Brazil's Gustavo Kuerten has also been awarded a wild card.

Benny Berthet Day, in which many of the players take part in one-set exhibition matches in aid of charity, will take place on Saturday 24 May, alongside the final matches of the qualifying tournament. The men's qualifying tournament begins on Tuesday, with the 16 qualifiers emerging on Friday. Women's qualifying starts on Wednesday, with the 12 qualifiers also decided on Friday.

The draw for this year's men's and women's singles will take place on Friday 23 May at 11:30 local time, and appear live on the Roland Garros website: [www.rolandgarros.com](http://www.rolandgarros.com).

## Davis Cup Play-off venues confirmed

The ITF has announced the venues for the eight Davis Cup by BNP Paribas World Group Play-off ties on 19-21 September. Great Britain has chosen Wimbledon, the scene of its 4-1 defeat of Croatia last year, as its venue as it attempts to retain its World Group status against Austria. World No. 1 Roger Federer has announced his intention of representing Switzerland against Belgium at home in Lausanne while Israel has chosen Ramat Hasharon for the fifth consecutive tie. ## Tomic and Rus head Italian Open entry

Europe's Grade A tournament, the Trofeo Bonfiglio Italian Open, gets underway today with five of the world's top ten boys and four of the top ten girls in action. In both events the seedings will be headed by the Australian Open champions, undefeated in 2008 but pursued by challengers with impressive clay-court records.

Bernard Tomic (AUS) stormed to number three in the world rankings after winning his home Grand Slam in Australia in January, but has not played on the ITF Junior Circuit since. Tomic has comparatively little experience on clay and will have to produce his best tennis to see off the Central and South Americans snapping at his heels.

Cesar Ramirez (MEX) won the Grade A Casablanca Cup on hard courts in his homeland at the start of the year and as a quarterfinalist at Roland Garros last year, he definitely looks capable of winning in Italy. Right behind Ramirez in the rankings is Jose Pereira (BRA), who won this year's previous clay-court Grade A, the Gerdau Cup in Brazil, and has a junior career record on clay of 42-5. The other two members of the top ten in action in Italy, Argentina's Juan Vazquez Valenzuela and El Salvador's Marcelo Arevalo, have also had success on clay this year.

On the girls' side, world number three Arantxa Rus (NED) has mirrored Tomic's success this year, winning the Australian Open and then taking a break from junior tennis to concentrate on her professional ranking.

Rus's main rival in Milan could be world No. 5 Bojana Jovanovski (SRB). Jovanovski was runner-up in last year's Italian Open, and also reached the final of the Grade A Gerdau Cup this year. Her conqueror in the Gerdau Cup final, Elena Bogdan of Romania, should also be in contention for the title. A dangerous floater could be Andreea-Roxana Vaideanu (ITA), who reached the semifinals last year but needed a wild card to get into the tournament due to having played just one ITF Junior Circuit tournament since.

Second seed Noppawan Lertcheewakarn (THA) has won her last three tournaments at Grade 1 level and risen to number four in the world, but all her best results have come on the hard courts of Asia and it remains to be seen if she can transfer this form to European clay. ## Kunieda, Vergeer and Wagner on form in Japan

For the second successive year, Shingo Kunieda (JPN), Esther Vergeer (NED) and David Wagner (USA) took the singles titles at the Japan Open, the second Super Series event of the 2008 NEC Wheelchair Tennis Tour, which ended on Sunday in Fukuoka.

In the men's singles world No. 1 Kunieda progressed to a final against world No. 2 Robin Ammerlaan (NED). Kunieda sped through the first set before clinching his third successive Japan Open title with a 60 64 victory. Kunieda has now won eight of the last nine Super Series titles.

Vergeer collected her third Japan Open title in the women's singles after she defeated compatriot and world No. 2 Korie Homan 64 76(6). The quad singles saw world No. 1 David Wagner (USA) edge to a 64 46 64 victory over world No. 2 Peter Norfolk (GBR).

The doubles brought Kunieda, Vergeer and Wagner further titles as they paired up with Satoshi Saida (JPN), Griffioen and Bryan Barten (USA) respectively to win their respective finals.

The Japan Open Welcome Party at the beginning of the week included the presentation of the prestigious Brad Parks Award to Kotaro Shibata (JPN) in recognition of his services to wheelchair tennis.

The Japan Open was one of five NEC Tour events last week that bring to an end the 12-month qualification period for the Beijing Paralympics. This week's world rankings, published by the ITF on Tuesday, will be used to determine direct entry acceptance for Beijing, with the process of finalising wild card entries to follow in the coming weeks.
