

Swedish success at Invacare World Team Cup

Sweden's men's team prevented a Dutch clean sweep by winning the Invacare World Team Cup wheelchair event for the first time in Cremona, Italy. Netherlands won the women's, quad and junior titles, with the Dutch women winning for an unprecedented 21st time. By capturing its first quad title, Netherlands joins USA as the only two nations to have won all four events in the 24-year history of the ITF's flagship wheelchair team event.

There were no early surprises in the men's competition with the top four seeded nations reaching the semifinals for the second year running. Fourth seeds Sweden then secured a stunning win in the deciding doubles rubber against Netherlands after 21-year-old Stefan Olsson had defeated world No. 2 Robin Ammerlaan for the first time. In the other semifinal, second seeds France saved two match points in the deciding doubles to overcome defending champions Japan.

In the final, Peter Wikstrom (SWE) defeated former world No.1 Michael Jeremiasz (FRA) 64 46 60 in the opening singles rubber, before Olsson upset world No. 3 Stephane Houdet (FRA) 36 63 61 to clinch Sweden's first-ever men's success.

In the women's event, fifth seeds France overcame fourth seeds Japan in a deciding doubles rubber in the quarterfinals, and then upset second seeds Korea to set up a repeat of last year's women's final against top seeds Netherlands. However comfortable victories for world No. 2 Korie Homan and No. 1 Esther Vergeer ensured another women's title for Netherlands without the loss of a rubber.

In the quad event, world No. 1 David Wagner (USA) struggled all week, losing his singles rubbers against Shraga Weinberg (ISR) in the quarterfinals and Peter Norfolk (GBR) in the semifinals. Despite securing his first win of the week in the final against Ban Van Erp (NED), Wagner and Nick Taylor lost only their third quad doubles match since 2004 as Dorrie Timmermans-Van Hall and Van Erp clinched Netherlands' first quad title.

The junior event, once again supported by the Cruyff Foundation, ended with Great Britain and Netherlands contesting the final for the second successive year, but second seeds Netherlands avenged last year's defeat by winning both singles rubbers against the defending champions.

Men's World Group 2 saw top seeds Belgium and Great Britain win through to the final without dropping a rubber, earning both nations promotion to the top division. Great Britain kept their No. 1 player David Phillipson fresh for the deciding doubles rubber, which they won 61 61. Germany also earned promotion to World Group 1 after their play-off win over Argentina.

During this year's event, title sponsor Invacare hosted an International and Scientific Symposium based around the topic of 'Sport and Disability'. Thirty coaches will participate in this week's ITF Wheelchair Tennis Coaches Workshop in Cremona, with the Cruyff Foundation and International Paralympic Committee helping to fund the participation of coaches not attending this year's World Team Cup.

ITF announces approved balls and classified court surfaces

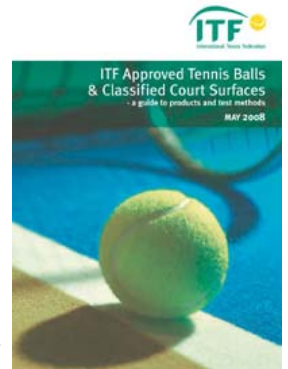
This week sees the publication of the 2008 issue of *ITF Approved Tennis Balls and Classified Court Surfaces – a guide to products and test methods*.

Compiled by the ITF Technical Centre, this annual booklet lists all balls that are approved for tournament play under the Rules of Tennis. In addition, over 130 surfaces that have obtained ITF Classification for court pace are listed. This comprehensive booklet provides information on the testing procedures for ball approval and court surface classification as well as contact details for all suppliers. All ITF National Associations will be receiving copies of this booklet by mail within the next few weeks. As additional balls are approved, and court surfaces classified, they will be listed on the ITF technical website: www.itftennis.com/technical.

New to this publication is the inclusion of a section entitled *ITF Guide to Test Methods for Tennis Court Surfaces*, which recommends the test methods for testing the key properties of surfaces. This section is a revision to the *Initial ITF Study on Performance Characteristics for Tennis Court Surfaces*, which was published in June 1997.

Further developments to the *ITF Guide* are anticipated, and consequently this section is supported by a web-based resource to communicate such changes. It is hoped that the *ITF Guide* will promote the development of higher standards for tennis courts and facilities for players of all levels, and in assisting, wherever possible, in enhancing the enjoyment of those who choose to play the sport.

Countdown to Wimbledon

The qualifying event for next week's Wimbledon Championships began today, running until Thursday 19 June. Men's singles qualifying sees 128 players contest 16 places in the main draw, while women's singles qualifying sees 96 players chase 12 places in the main draw.

Loyalties in the Da Silva household were split during the Brazil F7 Men's Futures tournament held in Guarulhos, the week commencing 2 June, as brothers Rogerio and Daniel Da Silva faced each other in the singles final.

Rogerio, the elder of the two, emerged victorious having advanced through qualifying to capture his sixth career title. Younger brother Daniel now trails behind with five career titles to his name.

A strong field has gathered for the \$100,000 Women's Circuit tournament in Cuneo, Italy, the week commencing 30 June. Thirteen players ranked in the top 100 are entered, including Italian Fed Cup player Karin Knapp, who at No. 39 is the highest ranked competitor.
