US Open gets underway

The final Grand Slam of the year got underway on Monday with celebrations in New York featuring a ceremony commemorating the 40th anniversary of the tournament. In 1968 the US Open replaced the U.S. National Championship and opened its doors to all who qualified to compete. The ceremony was hosted by actor Forrest Whittaker and included a chronological procession of 25 past champions.

World No. 2 Jelena Jankovic (SRB) took to the court immediately after the ceremony, overpowering American wild card Coco Vandeweghe in straight sets, 63 61. An all-American clash followed when ninth seed James Blake took on Donald Young in a five-set match which lasted into the early hours of Tuesday morning. Blake emerged triumphant 61 36 61 46 64.

Olympic gold medallist and world No. 1 Rafael Nadal battled into the next round with a hard-fought victory over German Bjorn Phau 76(4) 63 76(4). David Ferrer (ESP) and David Nalbandian (ARG), seeded fourth and seventh respectively, cruised through in straight sets. In the women's draw, Olympic champion and No. 5 seed Elena Dementieva (RUS) booked her place in the second round with a 64 75 victory over Uzbekistan's Akgul Amanmuradova, as did fellow Russian Svetlana Kuznetsova, completing a 64 62 victory over China's Shuai Zhang.

There was good news for the British with number one Andy Murray easily defeating Argentine Sergio Roitman 63 64 60 and Anne Keothavong, playing at the US Open for the first time, saw off Alexa Glatch (USA) 62 62. She sets up a second round encounter with Italian Francesca Schiavone while Murray will now face Michael Llodra (FRA).

There were a few shocks on the opening day of tournament as No. 10 seed and 2007 semifinalist Anna Chakvetadze (RUS) went out to compatriot Ekaterina Makarova 16 62 63. There were also early departures for Israel's Shahar Peer and No. 22 seed Maria Kirilenko (RUS). In the men's draw, No. 27 seed Feliciano Lopez (ESP) was defeated by Austria's Jurgen Melzer 46 76(5) 62 26 64 and Juan Monaco (ARG) fell at the first hurdle against Japanese youngster Kei Nishikori.

Defending champion Roger Federer's bid for a fifth consecutive US Open title gets underway today when he takes on Maximo Gonzalez of Argentina. World No. 1 Ana Ivanovic will also start her campaign on Tuesday when she faces Russia's Vera Dushevina.

The USTA has launched wide-ranging green initiatives at this year's US Open in a campaign, which sees Billie Jean King as the spokeswoman, to encourage US Open fans and others to help preserve the environment. A number of schemes have been put in place, all official programmes and drawsheets will be printed on paper certified by the Forest Stewardship Council and over 80 recycling points exist across the site.

Brother and sister duo proves difficult to beat

Brother and sister Nouredin and Samaha Adam dominated the two tournaments which took place following a three-day training camp on the East Africa 13 & under circuit. The circuit was hosted by the Tanzania Tennis Association and held at the Gymkhana Club in Dar Es Salaam.

The Sudanese players won the boys' and girls' singles events at both competitions and Nouredin combined with Ibrahim Shabani (TAN), runner-up in both singles finals, to secure both doubles titles too. Samaha joined forces with Gisele Umumarungu of Rwanda, who finished as runner-up in the first tournament, to take victory in the doubles at the second tournament. The doubles title at the first tournament went to Michelle Onyanacha (KEN) and Samrawit Teklu (ETH) who defeated Damaris Musera and Patti Endo (KEN) 61 63.

The training camp was conducted by the ITF Development Officer for the region, Prince Madema, with the assistance of local and visiting coaches and attracted a total of 43 top juniors from the region. The objective of the camp was to acclimatise and to help determine seedings for the tournaments.

The deputy director of Sports Development, Rachel Masamo, said: "The Tanzania Tennis Association has done a fantastic job in organising the event. I would like to thank the ITF and CAT for their financial support. Federations alone would not be able to host such events if it weren't for the support of the ITF, CAT and local sponsors."

Kazakhstan surprises at Asian Junior Championships

Kazakhstan caused a shock in the girls' competition on the ITF 13 & under Asian Junior Championships (Group 3), defeating Uzbekistan, who have dominated this event since its inception, to take the first three places in the final rankings. Kamila Kerimbaeva (KAZ) defeated compatriots Yelena Nemchen in the first tournament and Alexandra Grinchishina in the second, to take the singles titles and then teamed up with Nemchen to win both the girls' doubles events.

After eight days of closely contested matches, points are awarded for each tournament and added together to provide a final ranking. This points ranking determines who will qualify to be on the ITF Team to participate in the next ITF development circuit as part of ITF's "pyramid of opportunity".

The two tournaments, which were held in Shymkent, Kazakhstan, followed a 10-day training camp organized by the ITF in Namangan, Uzbekistan and were attended by teams from Afghanistan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan as well as the host nation. This was the first time that the Kazakhstan Tennis Federation (KTF) had hosted an ITF junior development event and the first time the ITF had organised a training camp in the Central Asian region.

Uzbekistan proved their superiority by securing the top four spots in the boys' competition. Temur Ismailov (UZB) emerged victorious in tournament one and two respectively, defeating fellow Uzbek Timur Khabibulin in both events. Ismailov then teamed up with Mikhail Esipov (UZB) to win both doubles events. However, there were also fine performances from players from Turkmenistan and Tajikistan and another positive development was the participation for the first time of girls on the team from Afghanistan in the championships.

Vice President of the KTF, Adil Borlibayev, commented: "This is just the first step and the start of bigger and better things for Kazakhstan tennis. I feel these championships have generated excitement and motivated more young children to take up the game more seriously. The KTF now looks forward to forging a stronger relationship with the ITF by organising more ITF development events as well as entry level professional events."
