Venues announced for Fed Cup World Group Play-off ties

Roger Federer extended his grass court winning streak to 17 matches and increased his INDESIT ATP 2004 Race lead to 97 points after claiming an ATP-best fifth title of the year in Halle. Meanwhile, Andy Roddick has now won 15 of his last 16 matches on grass and jumped up to fourth position after defending his Stella Artois Championship title. The top seven players in the Race, plus eligible Grand Slam champions, automatically qualify for the eight-player 2004 Tennis Masters Cup in Houston on 13-21 November. The event is co-owned by the ITF, Grand Slams and ATP.

Hall of Fame honoured

Ahead of its 50th anniversary celebrations this July, the International Tennis Hall of Fame in Newport was honoured with a state of Rhode Island proclamation.

The proclamation was given in a State House ceremony on 7 June by Governor Donald L. Carcieri, and the Hall of Fame was honoured for its efforts in the historic preservation of tennis, accomplishments in honouring tennis champions, and contributions to the Rhode Island's tourism economy. Hall of Fame President Tony Trabert accepted the citation.

The 50th Anniversary Celebrations will take place on 9-11 July, at the end of the 2004 Campbell's Hall of Fame Tennis Championships. Events will include a Parade of Hall of Famers, a Black Tie Anniversary Jubilee Dinner and the annual official induction ceremony, this year featuring Steffi Graf, Stefan Edberg and Dorothy "Dodo" Cheney. More than 50 Hall of Famers from around the world will attend.

Sport England announce LTA funding

Sport England has announced a £500,000 investment boost for the Lawn Tennis Association (LTA). The investment comes on the back of important restructuring undertaken by the LTA in May and the continued moves by the organisation to modernise further. The funding will support twenty key tennis clubs identified through the LTA's Club Vision programme, who will be resourced to deliver the LTA's vision of more players and better players by strengthening the club infrastructure and enhancing access to playing opportunities.

The LTA has also unveiled its plans for a new National Tennis Centre at the Bank of England Sports Ground, Roehampton where the ITF headquarters are located. Construction on the new facility will begin mid-summer 2004 with final completion due in 2005. The Centre will consist of 16 outdoor courts covering all Grand Slam surfaces, 6 indoor courts, a gymnasium, sports science and medical facilities. It will also house the administration of the LTA. The National Tennis Centre will be constructed on land leased from the Bank of England and is funded by the LTA with support from The All England Lawn Tennis Ground plc.
