Italy and Czech Republic host semifinals

Italy and Czech Republic will both be at home in the semifinals of the 2009 Fed Cup by BNP Paribas after the two nations scored surprise World Group first round victories on 7-8 February. Italy whitewashed France 5-0 away in Orleans, while Czech Republic saw off Spain 4-1 in Brno.

In the semifinals, held on 25-26 April, Italy will be at home to defending champion Russia, who eased to a 5-0 win over China in Moscow. Czech Republic will host USA, who came from behind to defeat Argentina 3-2 in Surprise, Arizona. For further information, visit www.fedcup.com and www.fedcup.com/es.

The four World Group first round losers will contest the World Group Play-offs, also on 25-26 April, against the four World Group II winners, Germany, Serbia, Slovak Republic and Ukraine. Jelena Jankovic and Ana Ivanovic teamed up for Serbia in their 4-1 victory over Japan in Belgrade; Slovak Republic saw off Belgium 4-1 in Bratislava; Germany defeated Switzerland 3-2 in Zurich; while Ukraine overcame Israel 3-2 in Kharkiv.

The four World Group II first round losers will contest the World Group II Play-offs on 25-26 April alongside the four qualifiers from last week's Fed Cup Zonal Group I events: Canada (Americas Zone), Australia (Asia/Oceania Zone), Estonia and Poland (Europe/Africa Zone).

USA blended youth and experience as they recovered from a 2-1 deficit to see off Argentina in Surprise. After Jill Craybas and Gisela Dulko scored comfortable victories on the opening day, Dulko put the visitors in front with a straight sets win over Craybas. Seventeen-year-old debutante Melanie Oudin then levelled the tie with a 26 61 62 victory over Betina Jozami, before another first-timer Julie Ditty partnered doubles world No. 1 Liezel Huber to a 62 63 win over Dulko and Jozami.

USA is next on its travels to Czech Republic, who reached its first Fed Cup semifinal since 1997 with victory over last year's finalist Spain. Petra Kvitova was the Czech heroine with straight sets victories over Carla Suarez Navarro and Nuria Llagostera Vives, while Lucie Safarova also overcame Suarez Navarro as the hosts built up a winning 3-1 lead on the fast carpet surface.

The biggest surprise of the weekend came in Orleans, where Italy stunned a strong French team 5-0. The tie featured two marathon matches on the opening day. Flavia Pennetta saved a match point to defeat Amelie Mauresmo 26 76(7) 64, having trailed 4-1 in the final set, before Francesca Schiavone outlasted Alize Cornet 61 26 86. Pennetta then overcame Cornet 62 62 to give the 2006 champion a 3-0 winning lead.

Italy will now host defending champion Russia, who eased past an understrength Chinese team in Moscow. Svetlana Kuznetsova, Elena Dementieva and Anna Chakvetadze all scored straight sets victories to build up a winning 3-0 lead, and extend Russia's Fed Cup winning run to eight ties.
