## Roland Garros hosts 2010 Fed Cup draw

The ITF has announced that the draws for the 2010 Fed Cup by BNP Paribas World Group and World Group II will be staged in the Tennisium at Roland Garros on Wednesday 3 June, starting at 12 noon local time (10:00 GMT).

The four semifinalists from this year's Fed Cup World Group - Russia, Italy, USA and Czech Republic - will be joined by the four winners of the World Group Play-offs in the draw for the 2010 World Group. The four losers of the World Group Play-offs will go into the draw for 2010 World Group II along with the four winners of the World Group II Play-offs.

Four of the eight nations in each draw will be seeded according to the ITF Fed Cup Nations Ranking of 27 April, and will be drawn against the remaining four teams. The first round matches are scheduled to take place the weekend after the 2010 Australian Open.

Nominations for the 2009 World Group semifinals and play-off ties taking place on 25-26 April will be announced on **Wednesday 15 April**. For all the latest Fed Cup news, visit [www.fedcup.com](http://www.fedcup.com).

## Success for South Africa and Egypt at AJC warm-up event

David Souto of Venezuela and South African Chanel Simmonds captured the 18 & under singles titles at last week's International Junior Championships in Casablanca. The tournament acted as a warm-up event for this week's 32nd African Junior Championship (AJC) held at the same venue.

A total of 184 competitors from 33 countries took part in the event, with the top African players joined by competitors from Europe and South America in a stronger field than previous years. South Africa brought a quality team who will also attempt to defend the AJC team title.

Souto, ranked No. 19 in the ITF junior world rankings, dominated the boys' 18 & under events, winning both singles and doubles. He dropped a set in the semifinals against Ramy Kamal Aita (EGY), before defeating Nikala Scholtz (RSA) 62 64 in the final. Simmonds proved too consistent in the girls' singles, dropping only one set in her 26 60 61 final victory over Tunisian 15-year-old Ons Jabeur.

Egyptian players dominated the 16 & under events, with Karim Hossam defeating countryman Ahmed Al Bitar 61 64 in the boys' final, and Mora Eshak overcoming Yasmine Ebada 75 62 in all-Egyptian girls' final. Eshak and Ebada went on to win the girls' doubles title.

South Africa won three out of the four 14 & under titles, with Wayne Montgomery overcoming teammate Mathew Rossouw 62 61 in the boys' singles final, before the two players paired to win the doubles. Zimbabwe's Valeria Bhunu defeated Mayar Sherief (EGY) 62 46 76 in the girls' final, with South Africans Madrie Le Roux and Kay-Leigh Nicholas victorious in doubles. ## Dominican Republic and Guatemala qualify for regional finals

Dominican Republic boys' team and Guatemala girls' team won the North/Central America & Caribbean pre-qualifying event for the 14 & under World Junior Tennis competition in El Salvador.

The two teams advance to the North/Central America & Caribbean final qualifying event, which will be held in Boca Raton, Florida, USA on 1-3 May. There they will compete against teams from Canada, Mexico and USA for the region's two available places in the World Junior Tennis Finals on 3-8 August in Prostějov, Czech Republic.

Thirteen boys' and 12 girls' teams represented the 13 participating nations in El Salvador. In the boys' event, fifth seed Dominican Republic dominated its round-robin group, going on to defeat Nicaragua 2-1 in the semifinals and sixth seed Bahamas 2-1 in the final. In the girls' competition, third seed Guatemala won its round-robin group in convincing fashion, before overcoming top seed El Salvador 2-1 in the semifinals and No. 2 seed Honduras 2-1 in the final.

ITF junior team competition action continues this week in Casablanca, Morocco, where the African qualifying events in both the 14 and 16 & under age groups take place as part of the African Junior Championships. Also underway is the Junior Davis Cup & Fed Cup by BNP Paribas Asia/Oceania final qualifying event, held in Shepparton, Australia. Sixteen boys' and 16 girls' teams will represent 17 countries competing for the region's four available spots in the Finals in San Luis Potosí, Mexico on 29 September - 4 October.

### NEWS IN BRIEF

#### Obituary - Aleksandr Tsaturyan

The ITF was saddened to learn of the sudden death of Aleksandr Tsaturyan at the age of 62 while on site at a tennis event in Bulgaria.

General Secretary of the Armenian Tennis Federation, Tsaturyan was among the nominations for the new ITF Board of Directors. The former Armenian national champion enjoyed a successful career as a tennis coach and administrator, and received awards for services to the game from both the ITF and Tennis Europe.

ITF President Francesco Ricci Bitti said: "Aleksandr was a good friend to tennis and he will be sadly missed by all of his friends in the tennis family. He will be missed especially by all the players he has taken such care of in the past, where he has helped to develop talent and the realisation of dreams."

#### Obituary - Les Snyder

Former USTA President Les Snyder died on 8 April in Tempe, Arizona. Snyder, who served as USTA president from 1995-96, was an instrumental figure in the planning and construction of Arthur Ashe Stadium and the expansion of the USTA National Tennis Center in Flushing Meadows.

An ITF Board member from 1995-97, Snyder was also a long-time volunteer in the USTA's Southwest section, serving as its president from 1980-1982. In 1997, he was elected to the USTA's Southwest Hall of Fame.

#### Davis Cup date change

The Davis Cup by BNP Paribas Europe/Africa Zone Group IV event in Abidjan, Cote d'Ivoire, will now be played from 29 April until 3 May. Five teams will compete for promotion to Group III.
