## **8. FORMAT OF PLAY:**

Each tie will consist of three matches, two singles and one doubles.

The Main Draw for men and women will be on a knock-out basis, with a play-off system to determine the ranking of all participating teams. The Main Draw for the quads and juniors shall be played in a Round Robin format (see the 2009 World Team Cup rules).

## **10. ENTRY FEES:**

- ◆ 290 GBP per player (3 players per team)
- ◆ 290 GBP per coach for Men's, Women's, Quad, Junior Teams (only 1 per team)
- ◆ 635 GBP per Official staff member (must be approved by the Member Nation and have an official function in the team e.g. manager, physio, doctor, etc.)
- ◆ 635 GBP per fourth team member
- ◆ 360 GBP per guest (shared accommodation and breakfast ONLY)
- ◆ 760 GBP per guest (shared accommodation, welcome pack, tickets to official functions, breakfast, lunch and dinner)

**Please note:** Guests staying in the official hotels are welcome to use the official transportation to the tennis centre but please be aware that the players and coaches will at all times be given priority.

All fees (except the guest package of 360 GBP) include meals beginning with Dinner on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July and end with breakfast on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> August. **Please be aware that all teams are expected to stay until Monday morning as we cannot foresee what time play will finish on Sunday (depending on unforeseen circumstances/ bad weather etc). If you are scheduled to play and are not able to, you will be defaulted and this will result in a fine (see 2009 World Team Cup Rules attached).**

## **11. EARLY ARRIVALS:**

Players or Coaches wishing to arrive before Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July must advise the ITF as soon as possible. The cost of hospitality for those arriving early will be GBP 42.00 per person per night (based on twin room accommodation) and GBP 74.00 for a single room.

## **12. TRANSPORTATION:**

All participants are expected to arrive on **Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July** and depart on **Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> August**. Transportation will be arranged from and to **East Midlands and Birmingham airports only**.

**Please note** that any guests arriving with players/coaches will be able to use the official transportation however for anyone arriving individually they are likely to need to organise their own transport.

### *ARRIVING IN LONDON*

For those arriving into London airports, there are several ways to get to Nottingham. There are coaches, trains and internal flights. As an estimate, if you would like to get a taxi for your team from London to Nottingham, a car for 7 people would cost around GBP 200.00.
