## Line-up confirmed for World Group Play-offs

The line-up for the 2009 Davis Cup by BNP Paribas World Group Play-offs is confirmed after Brazil, Ecuador, South Africa and Uzbekistan all won their Group I zonal ties last weekend.

**The Draw for the Play-offs will take place on Tuesday 12 May at the ITF offices in London at 11:00 (10:00 GMT).**

The eight seeded nations are Austria, Belgium, Brazil, France, India, Serbia, Sweden and Switzerland. Seeds are based on the ITF Davis Cup Nations Ranking of 11 May.

Each of the seeds will drawn against one of the following unseeded nations: Chile, Ecuador, Italy, Netherlands, Romania, South Africa, Ukraine and Uzbekistan.

The 2009 World Group Play-offs will take place alongside the World Group semifinals on 18-20 September. The eight winning nations will contest the 2010 World Group.

## Italians triumph at Beach Tennis World Championships

Italian pairings captured both titles at the 1st ITF Beach Tennis World Championships at the historic Foro Italico in Rome 4-6 May. Players from 13 nations took part in the inaugural Championships, which became the largest event since the inception of the ITF Beach Tennis Tour in 2008.

Held alongside the Sony Ericsson WTA Tour event, the tournament comprised men's and women's doubles events, offering maximum ranking points for the ITF Beach Tennis World Rankings.

The men's competition attracted a strong and varied entry, featuring 32 pairs from 11 countries. However Italian pairs dominated the draw, going on to fill all eight quarterfinal places. The semifinals saw veteran third seeds Riccardo De Filippi and Marco Ludovici upset second seeded compatriots Alan Maldini and Cristiano Minighini to set up a final with the title favourites Luca Meliconi and Paolo Tazzari.

Despite their top seeded status, Meloconi and Tazzari were teaming up for the first time in major competition and performed well below par in the final. De Filippi and Ludovici dominated the match through powerful serving and strong determination, going on to win 62 62 and be crowned ITF World Champions.

Six nations were represented in the 16-pair women's draw, although Brazilians Joana Cortez and Aline Sokolik of Brazil were the only team to defeat an Italian pairing. Former tour stars Olga Barabanschikova & Natasha Zvereva of Belarus were expected to perform well, but fell short at the quarterfinal stage.

An all-Italian semifinal saw the world No. 1 pairing of Simona Briganti and Rosa Stefanelli set up a final against second seeds Franca Bruschi and Laura Olivieri. The title favourites made a great comeback to win 16 75 62 to retain their No. 1 ranking and earn the title of World Champions.

## Nine nations share titles at Seniors World Individual Championships

Nine countries won singles titles at last week's ITF Seniors World Individual Championships in Mallorca, with champions crowned in 10 age categories over the weekend.

Host nation Spain had a successful event, as Ana Salas retained her women's 35 title and Eduardo Osta won the men's 50 category in his first ever Seniors World Championships. Osta did not drop a set during the week, while Salas was only briefly troubled in the final against Eva Haslinghuis (NED) before winning 61 46 61.

Spain was also represented in the men's 45 final, but Alberto Tous was unable to stop top seed Manfred Hundstorfer (AUT) from retaining the title he won last year.

Klaartje Van Baarle (BEL) did not play last year in Turkey, but had been world champion in three of the four previous years. She easily defeated Marie Calleja (FRA) in the women's 45 on Sunday to win her sixth world singles title. Another player to add a world title to her collection was Patricia Medrado (BRA), who won her fourth singles championship in the women's 50. Medrado's fellow Brazilian Roger Guedes was not so successful in the men's 55, falling to Alan Rasmussen (DEN), who added a clay court world title to the one he won on grass in 2005.

The other four singles titles went to first time participants in the Seniors World Championships. Poland's Beniamin Budziak was the surprise winner of a men's 35 event that had included Juan Luis Rascon (ESP), the undefeated two times world champion, and former Top 100 player Sandor Noszaly (HUN). Budziak defeated Austria's Clemens Weinhandl in Sunday's final.

In contrast, Rodolphe Gilbert (FRA) proved why he had been the pre-tournament favourite in the men's 40 as he eased to the title without dropping a set, defeating Canadian Jean-Francois Mathieu 63 61 in the final.

Joanne Russell (USA) was unseeded in the women's 55 due to limited activity on the ITF Seniors Circuit, but her form during the previous week's team event marked her out as a hot favourite. She came through the draw without dropping a set defeating fellow American Sherri Bronson 61 62 in the final.

Sabine Krein Auer (GER) was also an unseeded winner of the women's 40 category. Krein Auer has played very little on the ITF Seniors Circuit, but disposed of top seed Lucie Schwab-Zelinka (AUT) and third seed Vesna McKenna en route to the title. ## Limborg to receive Brad Parks Award

The ITF and the International Wheelchair Tennis Association have announced that Jean-Pierre Limborg of France will be the recipient of the 2009 Brad Parks Award.

Limborg was responsible for introducing wheelchair tennis to Europe in 1981, five years after Brad Parks and Jeff Minnebraker first championed the new sport in the USA in 1976. Since then he has worked extensively to help promote the sport all over the world.

Limborg was the first European to compete in the US Open Wheelchair Tennis Championships in 1981 and was the catalyst for the development and promotion of the sport when he returned to France. This subsequently led to wheelchair tennis spreading across the Netherlands and then to other European countries.

More recently, Limborg has travelled widely in Asia, promoting wheelchair tennis at every given opportunity and he has made a number of visits on behalf of the ITF Silver Fund, particularly to Sri Lanka.

The Brad Parks Award is presented to an individual or organisation that has made a significant contribution to wheelchair tennis on an international basis. It is anticipated that Limborg will receive the award from Brad Parks himself during the 2009 Invacare World Team Cup in Nottingham, Great Britain.

## Australia wins junior team qualifiers

The Asia/Oceania boys' final qualifying event of the World Junior Tennis Competition, the ITF's junior team championship for players aged 14 & under, was staged last week in Kuching, Malaysia.

Australia, Chinese Taipei, Japan and Uzbekistan secured the four spots at the World Junior Tennis Competition Finals to be held on 3-8 August in Prostějov, Czech Republic.

In the semifinals, third seed Australia defeated sixth seed Uzbekistan, and fifth seed Chinese Taipei overcame fourth seed Japan. Australia defeated Chinese Taipei in the Final, while Japan won against Uzbekistan in the 3<sup>rd</sup>-place play-off.

This week competition continues at the same venue in Kuching, Malaysia, where the Asia/Oceania girls qualifying of the World Junior Tennis competition is staged on 11-16 May. Sixteen girls teams will be competing for the region's four available spots at the finals in the Czech Republic.

Meanwhile the South American qualifying for the Junior Davis Cup & Junior Fed Cup by BNP Paribas will take place in Puenbo, Ecuador this week. Ten nations will be competing for two girls' and three boys' places at the Finals in Mexico.
