## Federer seals place in the record books

Roger Federer completed a career Grand Slam and equalled Pete Sampras's all-time record of 14 Grand Slam titles when he defeated Robin Soderling 61 76(1) 64 in the Roland Garros men's singles final on Sunday.

Federer is just the sixth man in history to win each major at least once in his career after Fred Perry, Donald Budge, Rod Laver, Roy Emerson and Andre Agassi. Agassi, the last man to achieve this feat in 1999, presented Federer with the Coupe des Mousquetaires.

"It was probably my greatest victory, I was under big pressure," said Federer. "I did it and it's phenomenal. Andre said it was my destiny to win this and that I deserved it."

Soderling was playing his first Grand Slam final, having become the first man to defeat Rafael Nadal at Roland Garros, but could not prevent Federer surging to his 14th Grand Slam title.

On Saturday, Svetlana Kuznetsova defeated compatriot Dinara Safina 64 62 to win her second Grand Slam title. The 2004 US Open champion was in control throughout the match, inflicting a third Grand Slam final defeat on her compatriot.

"I'm really happy, it's very special here for me, winning for the very first time," said Kuznetsova. "I didn't expect it to be this year, but I played with all my heart. It's my favourite tournament and I'm happy to win it."

Lukas Dlouhy and Leander Paes won their first Grand Slam title together when they recovered to defeat surprise finalists Wesley Moodie and 38-year-old Dick Norman, who was the oldest men's doubles finalist at Roland Garros in the Open Era, 36 63 62. For Dlouhy, it was a first-ever Grand Slam title, while it was Paes fifth Grand Slam men's doubles title and his ninth overall.

Virginia Ruano-Pascual collected her tenth Grand Slam women's doubles title when she and Anabel Medina Garrigues successfully defended their title, crushing Viktoria Azarenka and Elena Vesnina 61 61 in the final.

After three previous defeats in mixed doubles finals at majors, Liezel Huber won her first Grand Slam mixed doubles crown, teaming with Bob Bryan to defeat Vania King and Marcelo Melo 57 76(5) [10-7] in the final.

## Berta and Mladenovic triumph at Roland Garros

Daniel Berta (SWE) and Kristina Mladenovic (FRA) added their names to the list of champions at the French Open on Sunday, winning the junior titles at Roland Garros.

In the boys' event, the early exits of several top seeded players shocked the tournament. No. 1 seed Liang-Chi Huang (TPE) was one of five seeded players to lose in the first round, defeated 16 76(6) 63 by Richard Becker (GER). The upsets continued in the second and third rounds as second seed Bernard Tomic (AUS) also crashed out, losing 76(2) 76(6) to Dominik Schulz (GER). Incredibly, only three seeds progressed to the quarterfinal stage. Eventual winner Berta's final opponent was the in-form Gianni Mina (FRA). Mina's tournament was characterised by battling performances, with three of his five matches going to three sets, including his quarterfinal with third seed Andrea Collarini (ARG), a match Mina

won 16 62 63. Berta had to stave off another typically strong fight back from Mina, before eventually sealing the win on his fourth match point, 61 36 63.

In the girls' event, top seed Laura Robson (GBR), was ousted in the second round, losing 76 (10) 16 63 to 17-year-old Sandra Zaniewska (POL). Second seed Ana Bogdan (ROU) and the current ITF World Champion Noppawan Lertcheewakarn (THA) fared no better, also losing in the first round. So it was left to ninth seed Mladenovic to claim the first Grand Slam title of her career without conceding a set to her opponents, much to the delight of the home crowd, defeating Daria Gavrilova (RUS) 63 62 in the final.

In the doubles, the unseeded pair of Marin Draganja (CRO) & Dino Marcan (CRO) claimed the boys' title. In the girls' event, second seeds Elena Bogdan (ROU) & Noppawan Lertcheewakarn (THA) were victorious.

## More success for Kunieda and Vergeer

Shingo Kunieda (JPN) and Esther Vergeer (NED) won their third Roland Garros singles titles last Friday as the second Grand Slam wheelchair tournament of 2009 drew to a close.

After losing just two sets in the last 18 months, Kunieda dropped two sets in three days in Paris, but still proved far too good for the rest of the field in defending his men's singles title.

Kunieda defeated Sweden's Stefan Olsson 60 46 61 in his opening match, while world No. 2 Stephane Houdet ended Dutch world No. 3 Robin Ammerlaan's bid to reach a third Roland Garros final. With three Frenchmen in the semifinals, Kunieda and Houdet overcame Michael Jeremiasz and Nicolas Peifer to set up Friday's

final, where Kunieda sealed a 63 36 63 victory to extend his winning streak to 65 matches.

In the women's singles, Vergeer and compatriot Korie Homan both won their quarterfinals against Aniek Van Koot (NED) and Britain's Lucy Shuker without dropping a game, and continued to ease through their respective semifinals against Florence Gravelier (FRA) and Sharon Walraven (NED). Vergeer went on to extend her own incredible winning streak to 360 matches with a 62 75 victory against Homan in the women's singles final.

While both second seeded partnerships went out in the semifinals of the doubles events, Vergeer and Homan justified their top seeding for the women's doubles final, getting the better of surprise finalists Annick Sevenans (BEL) and Van Koot (NED) 62 63. Meanwhile, Beijing gold medallists Houdet and Jeremiasz were too good for Ammerlaan and Maikel Scheffers in the men's doubles final, victorious 62 75.

### Obituaries

The ITF was deeply saddened to learn of the deaths last week of **Mauro Sabatini** and **Ricardo Mendieta Murray**.

Mr Sabatini had been Tournament Director of the Grade 1 ITF Junior Tournament Citta di Santa Croce for over thirty years, and under his guidance the tournament had developed into one of the most important clay court events on the ITF Junior Circuit.

He was involved in Italian tennis at all levels, as tournament director, referee and executive of the Tuscan regional association.

Mr Mendieta was a member of the Organising Committee of the ITF Junior Circuit Grade 1 Coffee Bowl for over 20 years.

The Coffee Bowl is one of the main junior events in the Central America region as well as in the ITF Junior Circuit, with past champions including Janko Tipsarevic, Nicolas Massu and Gisela Dulko.

Mr Mendieta's organisational skills and his enthusiasm for junior tennis helped to make the tournament the success it is today and he will be greatly missed.

### Tommy Robredo behind 'Memorial Santi Silvas'

Spain's Davis Cup star and current world No. 15 Tommy Robredo is the Tournament Director for this week's Open Diputacion de Girona 'Memorial Santi Silvas', an ITF 2 Series event on the 2009 NEC Wheelchair Tennis Tour, which features several world Top 10 wheelchair players.

Robredo has organised the tournament in memory of his long-time family friend and Spanish wheelchair player and tournament organiser Santi Silvas, who passed away in 2008.
