Nottingham showcases international wheelchair tennis

The 20th British Open Wheelchair Championships gets underway today in Nottingham, as the City of Nottingham Tennis Centre hosts a two-week festival of international wheelchair tennis culminating in the 25th anniversary Invacare World Team Cup.

As the second of the year's three Super Series events, the British Open has one of the largest and highest quality fields in its 20-year history, with 176 players vying for honours. Entries are headed by Beijing Paralympic and defending British Open champions Shingo Kunieda of Japan, Esther Vergeer of Netherlands and Britain's Peter Norfolk.

Kunieda tops the seedings for the men's singles as he bids for his third successive title, and arrives in Nottingham unbeaten in 65 singles matches since the start of 2008. His strongest opposition is likely to come from French duo Stephane Houdet and Michael Jeremiasz, and Dutchman Robin Ammerlaan, the only other former champion in the field.

Beijing Paralympic silver medallist Ammerlaan heads a trio of Top 10-ranked Dutch players that includes last week's Belgian Open champion Maikel Scheffers and Ronald Vink, while Sweden's reigning Masters champion Stefan Olsson is another contender.

Three-time Paralympic champion Vergeer bids for her ninth successive British Open women's title, enjoying arguably the longest winning streak in world sport, unbeaten in 360 matches since January 2003. She is one of five Dutch players currently ranked in the world's top seven, with her main opposition coming from countrywomen Korie Homan, Jiske Griffioen and Sharon Walraven, and French world No. 3 Florence Gravelier.

Three-time British Open champion Daniela di Toro of Australia is the only other former champion in the field, having won Sunday's Belgian Open for her second successive title.

Two-time Paralympic quad singles gold medallist Norfolk bids for a fifth British Open title. He is one of four former quad champions in the field, along with his biggest rival, world No. 2 David Wagner of the United States, Bas Van Erp of the Netherlands and Israel's Shraga Weinberg. Beijing silver medallist Johan Andersson of Sweden and American Nick Taylor will also contend for the title.

While competing for individual honours this week, all players will be hoping for confidence-boosting performances ahead of next week's Invacare World Team Cup, when France, Japan and Netherlands will all look to succeed Sweden as men's champions. A titanic effort will be required to prevent Netherlands from winning 22nd women's title, while the Dutch also defend their quad and junior titles.

Dimitrov and Mehikic win European Development Champs

Bulgaria's Martin Dimitrov and Zina Mehikic of Bosnia/Herzegovina captured the singles titles at the ITF/Tennis Europe 12 & Under Development Championships at Ankara Tennis Club on 7–10 July. The club also hosted the sixth ITF/Tennis Europe South East Regional Training Camp, which took place the preceding five weeks.

The development championships were played in a multiple round-robin competition format. The four best boys and girls from the qualifying rounds played against each other in order to determine the winner.

Dimitrov edged out Berk Iliescu (TUR) for the boys' title after both players had ended the final round-robin with two wins and one defeat. Mehikic won all three of her final round-robin matches to run out a convincing girls' winner. Iliescu and Ata Hergunvarim (TUR) were boys doubles champions, with Mehikic and Katarina Jokic (BIH) winning the girls doubles title.

Earlier 32 players and eight coaches from the Balkan and Caucasus region had taken part in the training camp under the supervision of the ITF/Tennis Europe expert Rolf Buhler (SUI).

Biröl Vural, organiser of the camp, said: "Having players from seven countries together creates an opportunity to practice and compete with players of different backgrounds and playing levels. It was especially important for our Turkish players who do not have enough opportunities to measure their level with the most promising players from other European countries."

NEWS IN BRIEF

Grand Slam sponsorships

Australian Open organisers have announced ANZ as a new Associate Sponsor, with a three-year agreement starting in 2010. Tennis Australia Chief Executive Officer Steve Wood said: "We are very proud to have such a highly-respected Australian company make such a major commitment to our event."

Australian Open 2010, presented by Kia Motors in association with ANZ, will take place at Melbourne Park from January 18 to 31.

Meanwhile the USTA announced that IBM has renewed its technology sponsorship of and business relationship with the US Open, and will continue as the 'Official Information Technology Solution Provider' of the US Open and one of six USTA Corporate Champions. The multi-year deal continues through 2012, and will make IBM a 20-plus-year sponsor of the US Open.

Australian Hopman Cup team

Lleyton Hewitt and Samantha Stosur will combine for the first time as Australia bids to win its second Hyundai Hopman Cup title at the 22nd tournament to be held in Perth next January. Hyundai Hopman Cup - the ITF International Mixed Teams Championship - will be played from Saturday 2 January through to a day final on Saturday 9 January 2010.

Obituary - Carl Forsythe

The ITF was saddened to learn of the death of Carl Forsythe on 12 July at the age of 76. Forsythe was an enthusiastic and supportive board member of the International Tennis Hall of Fame for many years. He started his own law firm in 1951, and went on to become chairman of the board of directors of the Crompton & Knowles Corporation.
