Players warm up for Invacare World Team Cup

Shingo Kunieda (JPN), Esther Vergeer (NED) and David Wagner (USA) won the singles titles at the British Open Wheelchair Championships in Nottingham last weekend. The three players will now bid to help steer their respective nations to victory in the 25th Invacare World Team Cup, the ITF's flagship wheelchair tennis event, which gets underway today at the City of Nottingham Tennis Centre.

World No. 1 Kunieda won his third straight British Open title, defeating French world No. 2 Stephane Houdet 62 76(2) in a repeat of the 2008 final. The two players could meet again in next weekend's World Team Cup men's final, with third seeds Japan drawn in the opposite half of the draw to top seeds France. France, who are bidding for their first World Team Cup title since 1993, are seeded to meet defending champions and No. 4 seeds Sweden in the semifinals.

The British Open men's doubles final offered another potential World Team Cup men's final encounter as Houdet and fellow Frenchman Michael Jeremiasz beat Maikel Scheffers and Ronald Vink of Netherlands. Scheffers and Vink join Robin Ammerlaan in the Dutch team that are second seeds for the men's event.

The world's top two players also met in the British Open women's singles final, with Vergeer lifting her ninth successive title after a 62 76(5) victory over Dutch compatriot Korie Homan. Vergeer and Homan, who also teamed up to win the doubles title, now spearhead the Dutch challenge in the World Team Cup women's event, as Netherlands start as overwhelming favourites to lift the title for a 22nd time.

The British Open quad final saw second seed Wagner win his second title in three years, beating world No. 1 and defending champion Peter Norfolk (GBR) 62 63 after an impressive display that sees the American displace his opponent at the top of the quad singles rankings.

Wagner also defeated Norfolk in the doubles final, partnering Nick Taylor (USA) to victory over Norfolk and Jamie Burdekin (GBR). With USA and Great Britain the top two seeds for the World Team Cup quad event, the Britons will be looking to avenge both defeats this week.

Having won the last two World Team Cup junior titles between them, defending champion Netherlands and Great Britain are seeded to meet again in the final of this year's event, which is supported by the Cruyff Foundation.

The 187 players from 33 nations competing in the 25th-anniversary Invacare World Team Cup braved some damp conditions as they were welcomed on to centre court for Sunday's opening ceremony. Invacare World Team Cup Ambassador Rainer Kuschall, representing Invacare Europe, and Martin McElhatton, president of the International Wheelchair Tennis Association, welcomed the players, coaches and officials competing in the event.

European teams bid for Junior Davis Cup and Fed Cup Finals

This week's Borotra Cup (boys) and Helvetie Cup (girls) 16 & under team events are acting as the European qualifying events for the Junior Davis Cup and Junior Fed Cup by BNP Paribas Finals in San Luis Potosi, Mexico.

Twenty-eight nations have entered both events. The Borotra Cup qualifying rounds are taking place at four venues on 29-31 July, with the final round held in Le Touquet, France on 3-5 August. The Helvetie Cup qualifying rounds are also taking place at four venues on 29-31 August, with the final round held in Leysin, Switzerland on 3-5 August.

Six nations will qualify for both the Junior Davis and Fed Cup Finals in San Luis Potosi on 29 September – 4 October. For further information, visit www.tenniseurope.org.
