Early squads announced for September ties

Austria, Brazil and South Africa are the first nations to announce their squads for September's Davis Cup by BNP Paribas World Group Play-off ties. Nations have until Tuesday 8 September to confirm their four-man teams for the World Group semifinal and play-off ties, which take place on 18-20 September.

Jurgen Melzer will lead an unchanged Austrian team against Chile in Rancagua on clay. Stefan Koubek, Alexander Peya and Julian Knowle complete the line-up, as Austria contests the World Group Play-offs for the sixth successive year.

Brazil has chosen a full-strength team of Thomaz Bellucci, Marcos Daniel, Marcelo Melo and Andre Sa for its home tie against Ecuador in Porto Alegre. Thiago Alves, Franco Ferreiro and Bruno Soares will act as alternates for the team, which is bidding to reach the World Group for the first time since 2003.

South Africa has named a squad of five players, from which four will be selected to face India on an indoor hard court in Johannesburg. Wesley Moodie returns to the team and is expected to resume his successful doubles partnership with Jeff Coetzee, while the other three players named are Rik de Voest, Izak van der Merwe and Raven Klaasen. South Africa dominates 18 & under circuit

South Africa dominated this year's ITF South/Central Africa 18 & under Circuit, capturing four of the six singles titles on offer. Ten countries from the South and Central African region took part in the three-week circuit, which consisted of three ITF Grade 4 junior events in Botswana and Namibia. These events provided players from the region with an opportunity to earn ITF Junior World Ranking points and gauge their level against each other and an overseas entry.

South Africa filled three of the four final places in the first event in Windhoek. Hernus Pieters lost to Germany's Sebastian Richter 63 63 in the boys' final, while Natasha Fourouclas overcame compatriot Tracy Plant 63 75 in the girls' final. Pieters went on to win the second event at the same venue, defeating teammate Jaryd Botha 67 76 75, while Zarah Razafimahatratra won an all-Madagascan girls' final, overcoming fellow ITF/SATA training centre member Niriantsa Rasolomalala 75 75.

South Africa captured both events in the final week in Botswana, with Marlu Janse Van Vuuren overcoming compatriot Renier Moolman 75 63, and Sarah Ive defeating Razafimahatratra 62 46 64.

Karl Davies, ITF Development Officer for the region, said: "I look forward to all the players taking note of their performances and working hard to improve their tennis so that they can progress to higher graded events and improve upon their results in time for next year's circuit."

ITF Super-Seniors Championships

The ITF has received 112 team entries from 24 countries for the 2009 ITF Super-Seniors World Team Championships. The event will be held in Perth, Australia, on 2-7 November for the women's 60 to 75 and men's 60 to 80 age categories. The team nomination deadline is Monday 21 September.

The Super-Seniors World Individual Championships will be staged the following week on 8-15 November for women's 60 to 80 and men's 60 to 85 age-groups. The entry deadline for the Individual Championships is Monday 28 September.

The Sony Ericsson WTA Tour has announced the appointment of David Shoemaker as its new President. Shoemaker, 38, previously the Tour's Chief Operating Officer, General Counsel and Head of the Asia-Pacific region, succeeds Stacey Allaster, who was recently appointed Chairman and CEO of the Sony Ericsson WTA Tour.

In his new role, in addition to continuing to oversee the Tour's Asian operations in Beijing, Shoemaker will be responsible for the overall day-to-day operations and business affairs of the Tour; tournament and player relations; strategic expansion of the sport in key growth markets; international television and digital media rights distribution; and the Tour's year-end Championships.
