Roland Garros junior champions head Osaka entry

Roland Garros junior champions Daniel Berta, of Sweden, and Kristina Mladenovic, of France, head a world class field for this week's Osaka Mayor's Cup, the penultimate Grade A event on the 2009 ITF Junior Circuit.

Ranked No. 2 in the world rankings for 15 consecutive weeks, Berta is looking to replace India's Yuki Bhambri at the top of the boys' rankings with victory in Osaka. The top seed captured his first Grand Slam title in Paris in May before reaching the semifinals of the European Junior Championships, but was defeated in the first round of last month's US Open.

Liang-Chi Huang, seeded No. 2, looks to become the first Chinese Taipei winner, while the traditionally strong Japanese contingent is led by No. 4 seed Shuichi Sekiguchi. The seeds also include India's Vaidik Munshaw, who is hoping to emulate his compatriot Bhambri, the winner of last year's event; and Jason Kubler, a member of Australia's Junior Davis Cup by BNP Paribas winning team.

In the girls' draw, Mladenovic, the current world No. 2, is also looking to bounce back from her shock first round exit at the US Open. The French player is aiming to return to the top of the girls' rankings, having been overtaken by world champion Noppawan Lertcheewakarn last week. With the Thai player not participating in Osaka, Mladenovic has an opportunity to strike a decisive blow in the race for the 2009 Junior World Champion title.

Second seed Timea Babos of Hungary returns to Japan after winning the Grade 1 Japan Open in March, while the field also features Croatia's Silvia Njiric, the world No. 8, and former world No. 2 Ana Bogdan of Romania, a wild card entry. London 2012 Tennis Olympic Pictogram unveiled

The London Organising Committee of the Olympic and Paralympic Games (LOCOG) has unveiled the London 2012 Olympic Pictograms, the visual representations of each Olympic sport that will be used in the run up to and during the Olympic Games in 2012. Included is the Pictogram for the Olympic Tennis Event to be held at the All England Club, Wimbledon.



The 38 pictograms represent the sports and disciplines at the Games and will be used for signage, on tickets and on the field of play at Games-time, becoming an important 'wayfinder' tool for spectators.

IOC Coordination Commission Chairman Denis Oswald said, "The pictograms of an Olympic Games are a unique link between the host city and the sports involved. The London 2012 pictograms are a strong and dynamic representation of the 2012 sports and are instantly recognisable as part of London's look. The Olympic summer sports are delighted by these designs and I hope that they will not just help people to find their way to the events but will also encourage young people to try out different Olympic sports as we head towards 2012."

Olympic Games pictograms were first used at the 1948 Games in London and have become a regular feature of the Olympic movement since the Tokyo Games in 1964. For further information, visit www.london2012.com.

Wimbledon elects Vice Chairman

The All England Lawn Tennis Club, Wimbledon announced it has elected Philip Brook as Vice Chairman (effective December 2009), with a view to taking over from Tim Phillips as Chairman at the Club's AGM in December 2010.

The appointment, forming part of the long term succession planning for both the Club and the Wimbledon Championships, comes after Tim Phillips originally indicated his intention to retire in December 2009 on completion of 10 years as Chairman. Phillips was invited to remain in office until December 2010 allowing his successor to have one year as Vice Chairman.

Brook, 53, has been a Member of The Committee of Management of The Championships since 1997 and, as a player, is a former captain of Cambridge University lawn tennis team and Yorkshire Men's Singles Champion.

Obituary - Lu Zhengcao

The ITF was saddened to learn of the death on 13 October of Chinese Tennis Association (CTA) President Lu Zhengcao in Beijing at the age of 106 after 45 years in charge of the organisation.

President of the CTA since 1964, Lu spared no effort in promoting the sport throughout the country through a lifelong passion for tennis. During his 45 years at the helm, he focused on improving the sport's infrastructure, increasing its popularity in the new China, and developing and improving the level of competition.
