Prague hosts 2005 ITF AGM

The ITF Annual General Meeting is being held this week in Prague on 15-17 June, hosted by the Czech Tennis Association (CTA). This is part of the year-long Centenary Celebrations for the CTA. Over 90 nations are attending this year's AGM.

Thursday's Key Issues Sessions, ahead of the formal AGM on Friday, will include presentations from guest speakers Antoine Sire of BNP Paribas and David Howman of WADA. Other topics include Commercial, Finance, Constitution, Fed Cup, Davis Cup, Marketing the Game, Development, Seniors, Technical and the ITF Survey.

Functions include delegates lunches hosted by the LTA on Thursday and Fed Cup Champions Russia on Friday. The CTA will host a welcome party on Thursday in the Spanish Hall of Prague Castle, while the Gala Davis Cup Dinner, hosted by the Spanish Tennis Federation and the ITF, will take place at the Hilton Hotel on Friday night.

Elections for the ITF Board of Directors will also take place. Candidates for the Board, which will be voted in for the period 2005-2007, are:

Wheelchair Development Team complete training camp



ITF Wheelchair Development Team

The four members of the ITF Wheelchair Tennis Development Team have just completed the training phase of their trip to the Netherlands under the direction of Aad Zwaan, the Dutch National Wheelchair Tennis Coach. This week Pathmasiri Dissanayakalage (SRI), Johana Martinez (COL), Robinson Mendez (CHI) and Guangzhi Wang (CHN) will compete in the Merwede Amsterdam Open.

Martinez said: "I am very, very happy. This is a fantastic opportunity for me to improve and train with many of the world's top players, especially the best women in the world. This is unbelievable for me as I never thought I could play wheelchair tennis."

During the programme the team competed in a Dutch national tournament. Martinez won the women's second draw, while Dissanayakalage and Guangzhi reached the final of the men's second draw doubles. Mendez reached the men's main draw final, losing 64 61 to Maikel Scheffers (NED), before teaming up with Scheffers to win the main draw doubles.

This is an exciting new project aimed at assisting young promising wheelchair tennis players to benefit from training and competitive opportunities that are not available in their own regions.
