Captains' Meeting

When: Saturday 7 March 2026 at Ali Bey Club Manavgat (from 13.00pm)

Time: 13.15pm – Women's 60, 65, 70

Time: 15.00pm – Men's 60, 65, 70

Where: Fitness Area (signs will direct you to this area).

Captains' meetings are open to Team Captains only unless a request is submitted to bring an additional team member to act as an interpreter.

This will be followed by the Opening Ceremony

Opening Ceremony **When:** From 16.30pm, Saturday 7 March 2026 at Ali Bey Club Manavgat

All team members are to be at the opening ceremony in their nation's tennis wear (tracksuit or tennis outfit). Teams should be available at the Fitness Area (next to the captains' meeting) at 16:30pm. Full details of the Opening Ceremony will be shared at the captains' meeting. The Ceremony should conclude by 18.00pm.

Official Team Dinner: **When:** 19.30pm on Wednesday 11 March 2026
 Where: Ali Bey Club (Pool Side near Main Restaurant)

- Free of charge for all nominated Players and Team Captains
- Free of charge for all accompanying persons staying at Ali Bey Club Manavgat
- Cost for Guests not staying at the official hotel: 57.5 Euros per person
- Reservation Deadline for paying guests: 12:00pm Tuesday 10 March.
- Payment can be made on site by cash or credit card.
- Guests of teams who are not staying at the hotel will be provided with a wristband.

Medal Ceremony

Medal ceremonies will take place on Friday 13 March with medals awarded to all teams finishing from 1st to 4th place in each event. All medal teams (1st to 4th place) must attend the Medal Ceremony which will be held on Centre Court following the completion of all medal matches.

Official Practice Days

When: Friday 6 March and Saturday 7 March 2026

A practice court schedule will be made shared in an online Captains' folder (available mid-February 2026)

Practice Balls: Practice balls will be provided for a small refundable deposit subject to the balls being returned immediately after the practice time.

Draw Format

Draw Format: Teams will be drawn into Round Robin groups that will be played on Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday. Additional matches, including the Quarter Finals, Semi Finals and Finals will be played on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.

Match Times: *Unless advised otherwise, practice 1 will start at 8.20am, practice 2 will start at 8.45am and Ties will start at 9.30am each day.

Scheduling & Courts: Each tie will consist of 2 singles and 1 doubles match. Doubles matches must be played in all round-robin groups regardless of the score after singles.

* Afternoon ties will only be necessary if daily court requirements exceed 54, or if matches are delayed due to weather conditions.

Scoring Format

Singles Scoring Format (60,65,70): Best of 3 tie-break sets in all singles matches.

Doubles Scoring Format: All doubles matches will consist of a 2 tie-break sets and 10-point match tie break (this includes round-robin stage and knock-out position stage).

Order of Play: Order of Play and Practice times during the tournament week will be confirmed at the Captains' meeting and communicated during the week online and at the official hotel.

Format of Play

Format of Play is determined by the number of entries for a specific team cup.

Advancement of 2nd Placed Teams from the Round Robin Stage.

Draw Formats of 6 and 12-16 teams will advance group winners and 2nd placed teams to Quarter Finals.

Draw Formats of 17-23 teams will advance to Quarter Finals with group winners and one (1), two (2), or three (3) lucky losers, depending on the format.

The method is determined by the ITF Masters Committee, who last reviewed the procedure in October 2024.

Each group winner shall qualify to the main medal draw.

Any vacant positions in the main draw Quarter Finals (Draw Formats 17-23) will be filled by 'lucky loser' team(s) in line with the following process:

- All teams that finish in 2nd place in the final group standings will be ranked in order of their two (2) highest ranked players based on the latest ITF Masters Singles Rankings within the same age category.
- Not all 2nd placed teams will be included in the lucky loser draw process. The number of second-placed teams considered for the lucky loser draw process will depend on the number of vacancies:
 - If there is one (1) vacancy in the main draw quarter finals, this shall be drawn amongst the two (2) highest-ranked teams finishing in 2nd place in their round robin group.
 - If there are two (2) vacancies in the main draw quarter finals, this shall be drawn amongst the three (3) highest-ranked teams finishing in 2nd place in their round robin group.
 - If there are three (3) vacancies in the main draw quarter finals, this shall be drawn amongst the four (4) highest-ranked teams finishing in 2nd place in their round robin group.
- Vacant positions in the Quarter Finals shall firstly be allocated to the opponent of Line 1 (expected #1 seed), followed by Line 2 (expected #2 seed), and so on. Refer to the format of play for vacant positions.
- A "lucky loser" shall not be drawn to play the winner of their own round-robin group.
- Teams that are not drawn shall be included in the playoff stages for position 9th onwards.
- Draw Formats of 24 or more teams will advance group winners only to Quarter Finals.

Completion of Matches

All singles and doubles matches in the round-robin and playoff stage must be completed. This includes all medal matches. Failure to play any match shall result in all players in the team receiving zero (0) ranking points for their participation in the ITF Masters World Team Championships.

Notes:

- The mandatory completion of doubles matches in the playoff stage has been introduced by the ITF Masters Committee for all 2026 ITF Masters World Team Championships.
- Significant ranking points are available in the ITF Masters World Team Championships, based on wins at each stage of the competition.
- The ITF promote opportunity and participation. Teams often nominate four (4) players for the event. Non-completion of doubles often restricts the ability for players to compete in the event.

Player Registration and Accreditation

All players will be provided with accreditation that must be worn at all times on site.
Player Accreditation will be available for collection prior to the Captains Meeting.

Cancellation Details

Cancellation of booking must be 7 days before to avoid any charges.

If booking is cancelled or changed with less than 7 days, a charge of 3 days rates will occur.

Guests who are not staying at Ali Bey Club

Ali Bey Club is a private all-inclusive facility which is accessible for all hotel guests, and players competing in the World Championships. Guests of players who are staying outside of the official hotel shall be permitted access to the tennis facility at no charge in line with the following:

- Up to 2 guests per team shall be permitted with complimentary access to the tennis facility. These persons are required to pay €45.00 euros per day should they wish to eat or drink on site.
- Without limit, any additional guests of teams or players who are not staying at Ali Bey will be required to pay €45.00 euros per day, which will also allow them to eat and drink at the facility.
- Any player not staying at the hotel will be required to pay €45.00 for each day that they wish to eat or drink at the tennis facility. Players not staying at the hotel must not eat in the restaurant or have drinks/snacks from the bar unless this daily payment is made.
