Player Registration & Accreditation

Accreditation and welcome gift can be collected from the bar area of the tennis venue from:

Saturday 14 March: 9.30am – 5pm.

Sunday 15 March: 9.30am – 2pm.

If you are not on site on Saturday, this can be collected from the 'Australian Open' office on another day. Accreditations will not be re-printed for players that have competed in the team's week but there will be an additional gift.

Withdrawal Deadline: Monday 9 March 2026 at 10.00am GMT*

* A list of players who require a partner will be made available near the entry deadline.

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Main Draw and Qualifying Draw **Provisional Draw Sizes**

Singles Main Draw

- Maximum Draw size: 96 players
- Up to 92 Direct Acceptances (DA)*
(* 76 DAs if a qualifying draw is required + 16 Qualifiers)
- 4 Wild Cards (WCs)

Singles Qualifying Draw

- Maximum 64 Draw Size
- Maximum 2 Rounds
- 16 Qualifiers advance to the Main Draw

Maximum Player Acceptance

- Maximum of 144 players
- 76 Direct Acceptance (DA)
- 4 Wild Cards (WC)
- 16 Qualifiers

Alternates – Any singles entries exceeding 144 will be placed on the Alternates List (A).

Qualifying Events: If the number of entries in any singles draw exceeds the draw size of 96, a qualifying event will be held immediately prior to the singles main draw. Qualifying will take place on 14 March.

Players will be accepted according to Section 1, Rule 27 of the criteria for acceptances in the 2026 ITF WTMT Regulations. Players will be advised of their position (main draw or qualifying) by **17:00pm on Tuesday 10 March 2026**. ITF World Ranking points awarded to successful players, as outlined in Regulation 21 of the 2026 ITF WTMT Regulations.

Doubles and Mixed Doubles

- Main Draw Size: Maximum of 64 Pairs

Wild Cards

- Wild Cards awarded in accordance with draw size and WTMT Regulations.

Event Start Dates

Start times for players will depend on draw size and outcome of each draw. The list below shows the planned start time for each event:

Saturday 14 March

Men's Singles Qualifying (if required) – Maximum 2 rounds.

Mixed Doubles (Round 1)

Sunday 15 March

All Men's singles Draws

Women's Singles (Round of 64)

Men's & Women's Doubles Round of 32

Monday 16 March

Remaining Women's singles Draws

All remaining Doubles events.

Medal Ceremonies

- Friday 20 March – Medals will be awarded after all completed finals have finished on this day*
- Saturday 21 March – Medals will be awarded after the day's finals are finished.

*For finals matches completed on Thursday, 19 March, medals will be presented on court for teams unable to attend the Friday ceremony.

Practice Courts & Balls

Practice Courts will be available prior to the start of the Individual World Championships; however, these may be limited due to the World Team Championships taking place. Players wishing to practice on Friday 13 March will be able to do so from 16.00pm when team matches are about to conclude for the week. Further details will be available in February 2026.

A refundable deposit (if balls returned within 48h) will be required for practice balls.

Practice court bookings will be available from 9am on Saturday 14 March from the Australian office.

Bonus Event (previously known as Consolation Events)

Eligibility

- Bonus events will be held for players who lose their **first match** in either Singles Qualifying Draw or Singles Main Draw.
- Bonus events will **not** be held in Doubles competitions.
- New tennis balls will be provided for all Bonus Draw matches
- Players who receive a **walkover win** in their first Main Draw match, but lose their second may choose either:
 - to retain the rankings points earned from the walkover, or
 - to participate in the Bonus Event.

Ranking Points

ITF World Ranking points will be awarded in the Bonus event, in accordance with Regulation 21 of the 2026 ITF WTMT Regulations.

Draw Publication and Player Information

Draw Publication Times

- **Singles draws:** Published by 18.00pm local time on Thursday 12 March.
- **Doubles draws:** Published by 18.00pm local time on Friday 13 March.
- **Mixed Doubles:** Events starting on Saturday, 14 March will be published on Thursday, 12 March
Outstanding mixed doubles draws will be published on Friday 13 March.

Order of Play

- **Saturday, 14 March:** Detailed order of play will be published by **18:00pm on Friday, 13 March**.
- **From Sunday, 15 March onwards:** Daily order of play will be released no later than **19:30pm on the day before**.

Important

- **No On-Site Sign-In:** All entries must be completed successfully via the **online entry system**.
- Players must arrive on time for each scheduled match.

THERE WILL BE NO SIGN-IN ON SITE. It is the responsibility of the player to ensure that the (online) entry procedure has been successful, and that they arrive for each match on time. All players must be available to play anytime on the published dates of the tournament. If a player receives a bye in the first round, they may not be required on the first scheduled day.

Doubles Scoring Format: All doubles matches will consist of a 2 tie-break sets and 10-point match tie break (this includes round-robin stage and knock-out position stage).

Entries

Please note that players must have a valid ITF Masters IPIN in order to enter and compete.

Singles Entries

Online entry will be available from Monday **Friday 1 December 2025**, through the IPIN account of each player. All players are required to enter by the due deadline (**Monday 9 March 2026 at 10.00hrs BST**).

THERE WILL BE NO SIGN-IN ON SITE. It is the responsibility of the player to ensure that the online entry procedure has been successful.

Main Draw Singles Event

All players must be on-site and available to play from the published start date of each event. If a player receives a bye in the first round, they may not be required on the first scheduled day

Doubles/Mixed Doubles Entries

Doubles and mixed doubles events will be held in all age categories, using the format two tiebreak sets and a match tie-break in place of a third set.

All references to doubles below also include mixed doubles.

Doubles/Mixed Doubles entries will close on Monday 9 March 2026 at 10.00hrs BST (Withdrawal date for Singles) Players may enter without a partner. Where possible, any player that appears in the entry list after the entry deadline without a partner will be paired with another player who has also entered without a partner by the ITF office.

Entry Fee pay

Entry Fee Payment: Entry Fee: US \$150 **IPIN Fee:** US \$12 per player **Total Fee:** US \$162.00 per player

According to section I, rule 54 of the ITF Masters Regulations, **entries will NOT be accepted without the entry and IPIN fee of US\$162 (approx. €152/£126) which is payable by the entry deadline** per person whether for entry into singles and/or doubles and/or Mixed Doubles.

Players may enter up to three events (one singles, one doubles and one mixed doubles). Please note that any player entering three events must be prepared to play three matches in a day.

Method of payment:

Online payment requested via your IPIN account during the entry process.

Refunds: Refunds in full will be made if withdrawal is notified before the withdrawal deadline of Monday 9 March 2026 at 10:00am GMT. If withdrawal is notified after the withdrawal deadline, refunds will only be made for reasons of health/injury if supported by a medical certificate or bereavement. Withdrawals after the draw has been made will not be refunded.

Guests & Players who are not staying at Ali Bey Club

Ali Bey Club is a private all-inclusive facility which is accessible for all hotel guests, and players competing in the World Championships. Guests of players who are staying outside of the official hotel shall be permitted access to the tennis facility at no charge in line with the following:

- Players who are staying outside of the hotel will be permitted access to the Tennis facility from 4pm on Friday 13 March
- Players who are staying outside of the hotel will be permitted access on their days of play until they are eliminated.
- Practice courts may be reserved by players in advance for Friday, 13 March. Available time slots include 4:00–5:00 PM and 5:00–6:00 PM, each with a duration of one hour. Further information will be provided in February 2026.
- Up to 1 guest per player during the Individual Championships shall be permitted with complimentary access to the tennis facility. Should they wish to eat or drink on site, this person is required to pay €45.00 euros per day.
- Without limit, any additional guests of players who are not staying at Ali Bey Club will be required to pay €45.00 euros per day, which will also allow them to eat and drink at the facility.
- Any player not staying at the hotel will be required to pay €45.00 for each day that they wish to eat or drink at the tennis facility. Players not staying at the hotel must not eat in the restaurant or have drinks/snacks from the bar unless this daily payment is made.

Hospitality Money

Hospitality monies will be paid by the ITF for Main Draw events only (not for Bonus Draw events), as follows:

Singles winners: US\$800

Singles runners-up: US\$500

Doubles/Mixed Doubles winners: US\$600 per team

Doubles/Mixed Doubles runners-up: US\$300 per team

Payment will be made following the Event (US\$ or £GBP) bank transfer.

Hospitality monies are subject to players attending the medal ceremony on the day of the final of the event.

Please note that payments can only be processed until 1 month after the tournament end date. After this date, payments will not be made.
