

Update from 2025 guidelines: repositioning coaches closer to player benches

To assist with the implementation of these guidelines, the following court layout options illustrate acceptable placements for designated coaches' seating areas.


Option 1 – Same Side as Chair Umpire and Players

Designated coaches' seats to be positioned on the same side as the players and Chair Umpire. In this case, the seats must be located at the corners of the court side to ensure unobstructed visibility for the Chair Umpire.




Option 2 – Alternative Baseline Configuration


If Option 1 is not feasible, and both sides of the baseline are available, designated coaches' seats should be placed on each side of the baseline, maintaining proximity to the players' end of the court.



Option 3 – Single-Side Baseline Configuration

If only one side of the baseline is available (example, due to an adjacent court or wall), both designated coaches' seats may be positioned on the same available side of the baseline.





Should none of the three outlined seating options be feasible, Tournament Directors or Supervisors are required to contact the ITF Beach Tennis Department to determine an appropriate and approved alternative for the coaches seating placement.
