Chasing a Grand Slam spot

- You Xiaodi (CHN) – Won the biggest title of her career at W100 Luan (CHN) as she returns to the Top 200 for the first time since June 2024.

ITF Pathway

- Jeline Vandromme (BEL) – 2025 US Open girls' singles champion won the biggest professional title of her career at W50 Nantes (FRA) as she closes in on the WTA Top 200.

- **YOU** won her first ITF World Tennis Tour title since 2020 and 7th overall, 6 of which have come on hard courts.
- Unseeded, You defeated qualifier Sofya Lansere 64 67(2) 64 in the final on Sunday 5 April.
- The victory is You's **biggest title to date**. Her previous biggest title came at W60 Jinan (CHN) in September 2019. She has also won 3 \$10,000 titles in 2015 and 2 W25 titles in 2019 and 2020.
- The victory is You's **first title at any level since February 2020**, when she won W25 Rancho Santa Fe, CA (USA). She finished runner-up at 8 events between March 2020 and her title at Luan last week, including at W75 Vero Beach, FL (USA) in February (l. Bianca Andreescu (CAN)).
- **Elsewhere on the ITF World Tennis Tour in 2026**, You reached the semifinals at W75 Kofu (JPN) in March (l. Ma YeXin (CHN)).
- **Above ITF World Tennis Tour-level in 2026**, You attempted to qualifying at the WTA Tour events at Adelaide and Austin, falling in the 1st round of qualifying on both occasions. She also competed at a WTA125 event at Midland (USA) in February, reaching the 2nd round (d. Lia Karatancheva (BUL), l. Alina Charaeva)).
- By winning the title, You has **broken back inside the WTA Top 200 for the first time since June 2024**, when she was ranked at No. 200 for the week commencing 10 June. She has risen 54 places in the WTA rankings from No. 247 to No. 193, her highest ranking since June 2021 when she was also ranked at No. 193. She reached a career-high ranking of No. 166 in March 2020.
- You has competed in **qualifying at 10 Grand Slam tournaments**, most recently at all 4 Grand Slam events in 2024. Her best result in Grand Slam qualifying is reaching the 2nd round of qualifying at the 2022 Australian Open and at 2024 Roland Garros.

[Jeline Vandromme \(BEL\)](#) – [W50 Nantes \(FRA\)](#) – aged 18 (born 16 November 2007)

- **VANDROMME** won her first ITF World Tennis Tour title in 2026 and 5th overall, all on hard courts.
- Unseeded, Vandromme defeated No. 1 seed Mona Barthel (GER) in the final on Sunday 5 April. She was leading 3-2 when Barthel retired due to injury. She won from a set down in the 2nd round against Veronika Podrez (UKR) and the semifinals against Vivian Wolff (USA).
- The victory is Vandromme's **biggest title to date**. Her 4 other titles all came in 2025 – at W15 Manacor (ESP) in March and at 3 consecutive events in July and August, at W35 Roehampton (GBR) and back-to-back W15 events at Monastir (TUN).
- **Elsewhere on the ITF World Tennis Tour in 2026**, Vandromme finished runner-up at W50 Grenoble (FRA) on 15 February (l. Celine Naef (SUI)), reached the semifinals at W50 Helsinki (FIN) in March (l. Gao Xinyu (CHN)) and reached the quarterfinals at W75 Porto (POR) in January and W75 Maribor (SLO) and W50 Croissy-Beaubourg (FRA) in March.
- By winning the title, Vandromme has risen to a **new career-high ranking** of No. 222. She began 2026 ranked at No. 343 and has recorded a new career-high ranking 6 times so far in 2026 including this week.
- Vandromme **began 2025** ranked at No. 1036 and rose nearly 700 places in the WTA rankings to end the year ranked at No. 344 on 22 December.
- Vandromme is a **current junior Grand Slam champion and former junior world No. 2**. She ended her junior career by winning the girls' singles title at the 2025 US Open (d. Lea Nilsson (SWE)) and the girls' singles title at the 2025 ITF World Tennis Tour Junior Finals in Chengdu (d. Kristina Penickova (USA)), reaching the No. 2 ranking following the event.
- Vandromme made her **Billie Jean King Cup debut for Belgium** in 2025, winning both matches she contested, defeating France's Alize Cornet at the Europe/Africa Group I event in Vilnius, Lithuania in April and Germany's Anna-Lena Friedsam at the Play-offs in November. She has not been nominated for Belgium's tie against USA at the Qualifiers this week.
