The ITF Award for Outstanding Achievement in Seniors Tennis, awarded for the first time in 2012, is for Senior players who achieve exceptional results at the ITF Seniors World Team & Individual Championships. A player qualifies for the award by achieving the following criteria:

AWARD CRITERIA

1. 10 or more ITF Young/Seniors/Super Seniors World Team Championships
- and;
2. 10 or more ITF Young/Seniors/Super Seniors World Individual Singles Championships

Only a very small number of remarkable players have achieved the criteria for the ITF Seniors Outstanding Achievement Award. These players are:

Any player who achieves the criteria will be contacted by the ITF and presented the Outstanding Achievement Award by the International Tennis Federation. A suitable occasion will be selected by the ITF to present this special award.
