

The 2021 ITF Seniors Tour consists of three World Team & Individual Championships which are scheduled to take place as follows:

### **Umag, Croatia**

1. The **2021 ITF Seniors (50-55-60) World Team & Individual Championships** is scheduled to take place in Umag, Croatia from Sunday 29 August – Saturday 11 September 2021 (*re-scheduled from 6-19 June 2021*). The Team Event will take place from 29 August - 3 September 2021. The Individual Event from 4 - 11 September 2021.
2. The **2021 ITF Young Seniors (30\*-35-40-45 years) World Team & Individual Championships** is scheduled to take place in Umag, Croatia from Sunday 12 September - Saturday 25 September 2021. The Team Event will take place from 12 - 17 September 2021. The Individual Event from 18 - 25 September 2021.

*The ITF Seniors Committee, with the support of external travel advisors, reviewed the travel situation for each of the 34 nations that regularly attend the ITF Seniors World Team Championships in both March 2021, and again in May 2021. This review included an analysis of the Covid-19 situation on a global scale, but most particularly in Croatia. The analysis also assessed whether it was possible to travel to and from Croatia without restriction or quarantine.*

*In March 2021, over half of the nations were assessed as 'red' where travel to or from Croatia was not possible. Only 3 nations were assessed as 'green' where travel was possible without restrictions or quarantine. Other nations were assessed 'amber' where travel was possible although not advised. This assessment supported the decision to postpone the Seniors (50-55-60) World Championships from June 2021 to a later date.*

*In May 2021, the committee conducted the same review which saw an improved situation with 23 of the 34 regularly attending nations assessed as 'green' where travel to and from Croatia was possible at that time. Players from multiple other nations are also able to travel to and from Croatia without quarantine. In these cases, players must meet one of [5 entry requirement criteria](#) outlined by the Croatian authorities. Seven nations were assessed as 'red' which include Australia, Brazil, Chile, India, New Zealand, Norway, and South Africa. Whilst it is recognised that further improvements are likely in the months ahead, there is considerable risk that these nations will not be able to participate.*

*With the improved travel situation for most nations, and the pattern for further improvements in the months ahead, the Committee determined that the Young Seniors and Seniors World Team & Individual Championships are viable to take place in Croatia between 29 August and 25 September 2021. Fact Sheets for each event are now available, with an entry deadline of 28 June for the Team Championships. The ITF will continue to closely monitor the situation in the weeks leading up to the event to ensure that a travel threshold is met that allows for most nations to participate.*

### **Mallorca, Spain**

3. The **2021 ITF Super-Seniors (65-70-75-80-85-90\* years) World Team & Individual Championships** is scheduled to take place in Mallorca, Spain from Sunday 10 October to Saturday 23 October 2021. The Team Event will take place from 10 - 15 October 2021. The Individual Event from 16 - 23 October 2021.

*The ITF Seniors Committee will next review and assess the global Covid-19 situation in mid-June 2021, with a particular focus on Mallorca, Spain, and the 65+,70+,75+,80+,85+,90+ age groups. In addition to this, a thorough analysis of travel for regularly attending nations will also take place.*

*Players and nations are advised not to book any travel or accommodation until the release of the tournament fact sheets. The Fact Sheet for the event is scheduled to be released following this review, approximately 24 June 2021.*
