



2022 ROLAND GARROS BOYS' SINGLES SEMIFINAL NOTES Friday 3 June

No. 10 Dino Prizmic (CRO) v No. 14 Gabriel Debru (FRA)
Gilles Arnaud Bailly (BEL) v Martyn Pawelski (POL)

On court today...

- The last remaining French hope in this year's junior singles draws, No. 14 seed Gabriel Debru, takes on Croatian No. 10 seed Dino Prizmic in the boys' singles semifinals today, with Debru bidding to ensure French representation in the Roland Garros boys' singles final for the 2nd straight year – after the all-French final between Luca van Assche and Arthur Fils in 2021. Neither Debru nor Prizmic have dropped a set in this year's competition – meaning that something will have to give today. If Prizmic is victorious, he will become the 2nd Croatian player to reach a junior singles final here, after 2005 champion Marin Cilic... who is in action in the men's singles semifinals later on Friday.
- The second boys' singles semifinal is an all-unseeded clash between Belgium's Gilles Arnaud Bailly and Poland's Martyn Pawelski. Bailly has won 2 clay court titles at Grade 1-level this season – and should he reach another final in 2022 at Roland Garros, he will become just the 5th Belgian player to reach the boys' singles final here. If Pawelski, the lowest-ranked player remaining in the boys' event, wins today, he will become the 3rd Polish player to reach a junior final at Roland Garros – after 2006 girls' singles champion Agnieszka Radwanska and 2008 boys' singles runner-up Jerzy Janowicz.

- [PRIZMIC](#) is bidding to become the 2nd Croatian player to reach a Roland Garros junior singles final – after Marin Cilic, who won the boys' singles title here in 2005.
- Prizmic is bidding to become the **first Croatian player to reach a Grand Slam boys' singles final** since Borna Coric, who won the boys' singles title at the 2013 US Open.
- Prizmic is also bidding to become the **2nd Croatia player to reach a junior Grand Slam final in 2022** – after Petra Marcinko, who won the girls' singles title at the Australian Open.
- Prizmic is making his **2nd Grand Slam appearance here**. He made his Grand Slam debut at the Australian Open this year, falling to Daniel Vallejo in the 3rd round.
- Prizmic's **best junior result this year** is winning the title at J1 Vrsar (CRO), defeating Tiago Pires in the final. He also reached the quarterfinals at JA Milan (ITA) (l. Vallejo).
- Prizmic reached his **first professional final** at M15 Dubrovnik (CRO) this year, falling to Gergely Madarasz in the final. He has a 7-7 win-loss record as a professional.
- Prizmic is coached by Darko Klavic.
- [DEBRU](#) is bidding to become the 26th French player to reach the Roland Garros boys' singles final.
- Debru is bidding to ensure **French representation in the Roland Garros boys' singles final** for the 2nd consecutive year – after Luca van Assche defeated Arthur Fils in the boys' singles final here last year.
- Debru is making his **3rd Grand Slam appearance here**. He reached the 3rd round here on his Grand Slam debut last year (l. Sean Cuenin) but fell in the 1st round at the Australian Open this year (l. Constantinos Koshis).
- Debru competed in **men's singles qualifying here** as a wild card this year. He reached the 2nd round of qualifying, defeating Arthur Fils before falling to Norbert Gombos.

- Debru's **best junior results this year** are reaching the semifinals at J1 Traralgon (AUS) (l. Mili Poljicak) and the quarterfinals at JA Offenbach (GER) (l. Pedro Rodenas).
- Debru is coached by Boris Vallejo.

- **BAILLY** is bidding to become the first Belgian player to reach a Grand Slam boys' singles final since Kimmer Coppejans won the boys' singles title here in 2012.
- Bailly is bidding to become the **5th Belgian player to reach a Roland Garros boys' singles final** – after Jacques Brichant (1947 and 1948), Gino Mezzi (1951), F Andries (1953) and Coppejans (2012).
- Bailly is also bidding to become the **2nd Belgian player to reach a junior Grand Slam final in 2022** – after Sofia Costoulas, who finished runner-up in the girls' singles at the Australian Open.
- Bailly is making his **2nd Grand Slam appearance here**. He made his Grand Slam debut at the Australian Open this year, where he reached the 2nd round (d. Charlie Camus, I. Yaroslav Demin).
- Bailly's **best junior results this year** are winning the titles at J1 Casablanca (MAR) (d. Gianmarco Gandolfi) and J1 Villena (ESP) (d. Alexander Blockx). He also reached the final at J2 Siauliai (LTU) (I. Jakub Nicod) and the quarterfinals at J2 Oberhaching (GER) (I. Vojtech Petr).
- Bailly is coached by Dries Beerden, Maxime Braeckman and Jean-Pierre Faniel.
- **PAWELSKI** is bidding to become 3rd Polish player to reach a Roland Garros junior singles final – after Agnieszka Radwanska, who won the girls' singles title here in 2006, and Jerzy Janowicz, who finished runner-up in the boys' singles here in 2008.
- Pawelski is also bidding to become the **first Polish player to reach a junior Grand Slam final** since Iga Swiatek won the girls' singles title at 2018 Wimbledon.
- Pawelski is making his **Grand Slam debut at Roland Garros**. He has played just one other event at Grade A-level, falling to Lorenzo Carboni in the 1st round at JA Milan (ITA) last month.
- Pawelski's **best junior results this year** are winning the titles at J1 Svyatopetrivske Village (UKR) (d. Danil Panarin) and J2 Bratislava (SVK) (d. Peter Benjamin Privara). He also reached the quarterfinals at J1 Santa Croce (ITA) (I. Bor Artnak).
- Pawelski is coached by Lukasz Kuboszek.
