Cesenatico, Emilia-Romagna, Italy, 16-20 May 2023

Information Circular

1. MEN'S, WOMEN'S, MIXED and U18 DOUBLES EVENTS

The 2023 ITF Beach Tennis World Championships will feature Men's, Women's and Mixed Doubles events (open to players who have reached the age of 14 years on or before 31 December 2022), plus an U18 event (open to players who have reached the age of 13 years on or before 31 December 2022), as follows:

1. Men's and Women's Qualifying: Monday 15 May – Monday 15 May 2. Men's and Women's Main draw: Tuesday 16 May – Saturday 20 May Tuesday 16 May – Thursday 18 May 3. Mixed Doubles: 4. 3. HOTEL INFORMATION / OFFICIAL HOTEL

4. HOSPITALITY FOR TOP EIGHT MEN'S AND WOMEN'S DOUBLES PAIRS

The top eight (8) men's and women's doubles pairs, based on players' combined ranking as at the entry deadline, will receive complimentary hospitality (twin room plus breakfast, lunch on site and dinner at the

hotel) for the duration of the competition at Hotel Nova. Hospitality will commence on the evening of Monday 15 May and end on Sunday 21 May.

5. HOSPITALITY / PLAYER / SHOWER FACILITIES ON-SITE

Players in the Men's, Women's and Mixed Doubles events will have access to an exclusive tournament area on-site where they can receive or purchase meals and refreshments and to an exclusive lounge area. These areas are controlled and open to players on display of an appropriate badge and not open to guests.

Men's and Women's main draw doubles pairs will receive complimentary lunch.

Water is available for both practice and matches but for players only.

Shower facilities will be available on-site, for exclusive use of players.

7. OTHER EVENTS

Dependent on the number of entries received in each category, a number of additional events will also take place during the Championships, as follows:

Seniors

Men's Doubles O40 & O50 Women's Doubles O35 Mixed Doubles O40

Juniors

Boys' Doubles 16U; 14U; 12U Girls' Doubles 16U; 14U; 12U Mixed Doubles 16U; 14U;

18U events will be organized in accordance with the ITF Beach Tennis World Junior Tour Regulations.

Seniors, 16U, 14U and 12U events will be organized in accordance with National Regulations, as issued by the Italian Tennis and Padel Federation (FITP).

8. ENTRIES

Entries for the Men's and Women's Doubles events will be online, via IPIN:

Entries for the Mixed, Seniors and all Junior events will be via entry form, which will be available on tournament website (www.wikibeach.it)

All players under 18 must obtain the consent of their legal parent/guardian prior to submitting an entry and such entry must include the name and contact details of the legal parent/guardian. All players must be in good standing with their National Association.

The Entry Deadline for the Mixed, Seniors and Junior events is 13 May 2023, following which Acceptance Lists will be published on (www.wikibeach.it)

Acceptance Lists are not final until the Entry Deadline.

Players for the 16U, 14U and 12U events must have reached the minimum age and not have exceeded the maximum age as of January 1st 2023:

U12: Born in 2011/2012 U14: Born in 2009/2010 U16: Born in 2007/2008

All players participating in "other events" must be regularly registered for their own Federation. Proof of membership must be given to the Referee at the time of sign-in.

Players for the 18U event must have reached the age of thirteen (13) years on or before 31 December 2022.

9. ENTRY FEES (per team)

Entry fees, as set out below, are 'per team'. Entry fees are payable at the Entry Deadline and following publication of the Acceptance List. Payment must be made direct to the organiser via PayPal, and as per the payment instructions provided on the entry form. Players in the Men's and Women's Doubles will be issued with payment instructions at the Entry Deadline. Any player who fails to make payment will not be permitted to compete in the Championships:

Any team that withdraws after the Withdrawal Deadline shall be liable for payment of an entry fee.

10. ENTRY DEADLINES

The Entry Deadline for the Men's and Women's events is at 14:00 GMT on Thursday 4 May, eleven (11) days prior to the Monday of the Tournament Week.

The Entry Deadline for all other events is at 15:00 local time on Friday 12 May.

11. WITHDRAWAL DEADLINES

The Withdrawal Deadline for the Men's and Women's events is at 14:00 GMT on Thursday 11 May, four (4) days prior to the Monday of the Tournament Week.

The Withdrawal Deadline for all other events is at 15:00 local time on Monday 15 May.

12. TRAVEL INFORMATION AND TRANSPORTATION

The closest airports to the venue are Bologna (106km), Rimini (29km) and Forli (41km).

From Bologna Airport, take the Marconi Express to Bologna Central Station. From there, take the train to Cesenatico, changing in Rimini.

From Rimini Airport, take bus 9 to Rimini Train Station. From there, take the train to Cesenatico.

From Forli Airport, take a bus or taxi to Forli Train Station. From there, take the train to Cesenatico, changing in Rimini.

Once in Cesenatico, take a short taxi ride (approx. 3-4km) to the site or nearby hotel.

13. VISA

Issuing Authority for Men's Doubles and Women's Doubles events:

For Men's and Women's Doubles, a visa supporting letter can be generated on IPIN when entering the tournament.

14. RULES & REGULATIONS

Players in the Men's, Women's, Mixed and 18U events agree to abide by the provisions of the ITF Beach Tennis World Tour Regulations / ITF Beach Tennis World Tour Junior Regulations 2023.

15. THE DRAW

The Draw will be made on-site in the Referee's Office on Sunday 14 May. Players are welcome to attend the Draw, which will be conducted by the Referee, as a minimum in the presence of ITF personnel.

16. DRAW SIZES / DRAW FORMAT / MATCH FORMAT

All events will be played as a knockout draw, according to the following draw sizes:

Men's Doubles:

Draw size: 32 Qualifying: 64

Women's Doubles

Draw size: 32 Qualifying: 64

Mixed Doubles:

Draw size: 64

18U Boys, Girls and Mixed Doubles

Draw size: *32

(*Where fewer than nine (9) entries are received, the event shall be played as a round robin format, in accordance with the ITF Beach Tennis World Junior Tour Regulations).

Match Format

Men's Doubles, Women's Doubles, Mixed Doubles and U18 Doubles:

Matches will be three sets – two (2) tie-break sets with a match tie-break (10 points) in the third set.

Other Events:

All other categories: matches will be three (3) tie-break sets (to 4 games) – 7-point tie breaks.

17. Prize Money Distribution

Prize money will be distributed as per the Tour Regulation for the Men's (\$20,000) and Women's (\$20,000):

Winners: 20% (\$8,000 per team)
Finalists: 12% (\$4,800 per team)
Third place: 6% (\$2,400 per team)
Fourth place: 4% (\$1,600 per team)
Quarter-Finalists: 2% (\$800 per team)

Please note for the Mixed Doubles (\$5,000) the percentage distribution will be double that of above.

19. BALLS

As a minimum (4) new balls will be provided for all matches in all events. The ball type is TBC. Balls will be changed at 9 and 11 games.

20. SELECTION OF SEEDS

Seeding for the Men's and Women's Doubles shall be based on the combined World Ranking position of each team, using the World Rankings published on Monday 8 May, the Monday immediately prior to the Qualifying Sign-in Deadline. Ties will be drawn using the system of merit. Teams where both players do not have a World Ranking shall not be given a combined ranking and shall not be seeded.

Seeding for the 18U Doubles shall be based on the latest combined Junior World Ranking of each team available at the time of the Draw. Ties shall be drawn randomly. Teams where both players do not have a Junior World Ranking shall not be given a combined ranking and shall not be seeded.

Seeding for all other events shall be at the discretion of the organizer.
